


ANNUAL ORANGE TICKET RAFFLE

How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat **one full meal**, as well as **two smaller meals** that together are **NOT** equal to a full meal.

What is Abstinence?

Abstinence is **refraining from eating meat** that comes from animals such as chickens, cows, sheep or pigs — all of which live on land. Birds are also considered meat. On the other hand, **fish** are a different category of animal. Salt and freshwater species of fish, amphibians, reptiles, (cold-blooded animals) and shellfish **are permitted**.

*Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the **physically** or **mentally ill** including individuals suffering from **chronic illnesses** such as diabetes. Also excluded are **pregnant** or **nursing women**.

FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

WHAT DO THE CONTENT AND TONE OF OUR WORDS TELL OTHERS ABOUT OUR HEARTS?

Scripture passages from the Book of Sirach and Luke's Gospel suggest a powerful standard by which we can judge the heart and mind of another person: the subject and manner about which one speaks.




Pretty obvious, isn't it? Negative people tend to speak negatively. Jealous people speak resentfully. Judgmental people speak suspiciously. Their conversations tend to weigh others down. By contrast, positive people speak positively. Happy people speak graciously. Energized people speak enthusiastically. Their conversations tend to lift others up.

If the eyes are the windows to the soul, conversation seems to be expressions of the heart. Francis de Sales writes in his Introduction to the Devout Life: "Just as physicians learn about a person's health or sickness by looking at the tongue, so our words are a true indication of the state of our souls." (Part III, Chapter 26) This diagnosis has several aspects.

First: **how do we speak of God?** "If you are truly in love with God you should often speak of God in familiar conversation with others...just as bees extract with their mouths nothing but honey, so your tongue should always be sweetened with its God...always with attention and reverence." (Part III, Chapter 26)

Second: **how do we speak of others?** "Be careful never to let an indecent word leave your lips, for even if you do not speak with an evil intention those who hear it may take it a different way." When one's heart is filled with evil or rancor or intrigue, their tongues are no longer like the sweet ones of the bees but become "like a lot of wasps gathered together to feed on corruption." (Part III, Chapter 27)

Third: **how balanced is our conversation?** "It seems to me that we should avoid two extremes," observes Francis de Sales. "To be too reserved and to refuse to take part in conversation looks like lack of confidence in the others or some kind of disdain. On the other hand, to be always babbling or joking without giving others time or chance to speak when they wish is a mark of shallowness and levity." (Part III, Chapter 30)



Scholarships for Florida School children

Step Up For Students believes that every child deserves the chance to succeed. Through the administration of several scholarship programs, Step Up For Students empowers parents to pursue and engage in the most appropriate learning options for their children. With the help of a Step Up For Students scholarship, you could send your child to a Catholic school near you.



SCHOLARSHIPS FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO) and the Florida Tax Credit (FTC) Scholarship Program give parents the ability to choose a school that best meets their children's needs by providing a scholarship to attend an eligible private school.

Who is eligible?

Students in grades K-12 who meet one or more of the following:

- Financial need: Eligibility is determined by household income. For example, a family of four could have an income of nearly \$100,000 annually to qualify.
- Dependent children of a reservist or an active-duty member of the United States Armed Forces
- Children currently in foster or out-of-home care
- Siblings of students participating in the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities

What is available?

- A scholarship worth roughly \$7,000 to cover the cost of private school tuition, books, registration, testing and more.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS WITH UNIQUE ABILITIES

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA) allows parents of students with unique abilities to personalize the education of their children by directing scholarship dollars toward a combination of programs and services offered by approved providers.

Who is eligible?

- Students 3 years old to high-school graduation or age 22 (whichever comes first)
- Children with one of 22 diagnoses including, but not limited to: autism spectrum disorder, Down syndrome, spina bifida and emotional, behavioral or intellectual disabilities

What is available?

- A scholarship worth, on average, \$10,400 to cover the cost of private school tuition, instructional materials, home education, tutoring and more.
