



The Year of St. Francis de Sales

2022 - 2023


December 28, 2022 is the 400 death anniversary of St. Francis de Sales, the Gentleman Saint, who lived a simple life and left a spiritual legacy for the coming generations. All the religious congregations and entities following the spirituality of St. Francis de Sales are making this important day as a time of celebration and commemoration.

The Superior General of The Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales, Very Reverend Dr. Abraham Vettuvilil, MSFS declared this year as the Year of St. Francis de Sales, marking different celebrations in all the 33 countries where Fransalian priests are currently working. The Year of St. Francis de Sales begins on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 24, 2022 and ends on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 16, 2023.

The focus of our celebration during this year is the study of St. Francis de Sales; imitation of his virtues; and applying his method of pastoral care with compassion and gentleness to everyone.

A Brief Biography of St. Francis de Sales

Francis de Sales was born August 21, 1567, near Annecy in what is now part of France. After his education at Annecy, Paris, and Padua, he was ordained in 1593. He became bishop of Geneva in 1602, but his residence and his cathedral were located in Annecy because of the religious opposition in Geneva at the time. The rest of his life was spent in the service of the people of his diocese, particularly in preaching and giving spiritual direction. He wrote two classics of spiritual literature, *Introduction to the Devout Life* and *Treatise on the Love of God*. In 1610 with Jane Frances de Chantal founded a new religious congregation, the Sisters of the Visitation of Holy Mary. Francis de Sales died at the age of 55 in Lyons, France, on the Feast of the Holy Innocents, December 28, 1622. St. Francis de Sales was beatified on January 8, 1661 by Pope Alexander VII, and canonized on April 8, 1665. His Feast Day is January 24th. In 1923, Pope Pius XI proclaimed him a patron of writers and journalists, because he made extensive use of broadsheets and books both in spiritual direction and in his efforts to convert the Calvinists of the region. St. Francis developed a sign language in order to teach a deaf man about God, because of this, he is also the patron saint of the deaf.

Programs Planned to Celebrate This Special Year by the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales - MSFS


In the Entire Congregation (33 Countries)

1. Pope Francis has agreed to write a letter on St. Francis de Sales to mark the 400th death anniversary.
2. Wednesday with St. Francis de Sales: Every Wednesday from April 27th: Nearly 13 Congregations and Lay Associates are participating in giving a 5-minute reflection on St. Francis de Sales spirituality.
3. Celebrations in Annecy (organized by MSFS Franco-Swiss Province) inviting Confreres from all over Europe.
4. A short documentary on St. Francis de Sales and a special calendar for 2023.
5. Starting the Formation Program for Fransalian Associates in all the Provinces in view of their consecration in January 2024.
6. On December 28, 2022 (death date of St. Francis de Sales), there will be a program at the congregational level to reach out to the people in need of support.

In the USA Vice-Province

1. Seminars and symposiums in different parishes on St. Francis de Sales
2. Adding a "Fransalian Corner" in the parish bulletins
3. Making Salesian literature available in parishes
4. Inviting parishioners to study the writings of St. Francis de Sales and live his virtues.
5. Mission preaching/workshops on Salesian spirituality in parishes.
6. Inviting faithful to join the lay apostolate of the Fransalians.


Year of St. Francis de Sales
