

EXPOSITION OF SACRED RELICS

Holy Spirit Parish welcomes you to a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics. Over 150 relics will be shown, some as old as 2,000 years.

Among the treasures will be relics of the Twelve Apostles, St. Joseph, St. John the Baptist, St. Mary Magdalene, St. Thérèse of Lisieux, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Maria Goretti, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska.

There will also be a fragment of the Veil that belonged to Our Lady and some of the largest remaining pieces of the Wood of the True Cross in the world.

FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

EXPERIENCE OF THE SACRED RELICS

Relics are physical objects that have a direct association with the saints or with Our Lord. They are usually broken down into three classes. First class relics are the body or fragments of the body of a saint, such as pieces of bone or flesh. Second class relics are something that a saint personally owned, such as a shirt or book (or fragments of those items). Third class relics are those items that a saint touched or that have been touched to a first, second, or another third-class relic of a saint.



Scripture teaches that God acts through relics, especially in terms of healing. In fact, when surveying what Scripture has to say about sacred relics, one is left with the idea that healing is what relics "do."

- When the corpse of a man was touched to the bones of the prophet Elisha the man came back to life and rose to his feet (2 Kings 13:20-21).
- A woman was healed of her hemorrhage simply by touching the hem of Jesus' cloak (Matthew 9:20-22).
- The signs and wonders worked by the Apostles were so great that people would line the streets with the sick so that when Peter walked by at least his shadow might 'touch' them (Acts 5:12-15).
- When handkerchiefs or aprons that had been touched to Paul were applied to the sick, the people were healed, and evil spirits were driven out of them (Acts 19:11-12).

In each of these instances God has brought about a healing using a material object. The vehicle for the healing was the touching of that object. It is very important to note, however, that the cause of the healing is God; the relics are a means through which He acts. In other words, relics are not magic. They do not contain a power that is their own; a power separate from God. Any good that comes about through a relic is God's doing. But the fact that God chooses to use the relics of saints to work healing and miracles tells us that He wants to draw our attention to the saints as "models and intercessors" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 828).

Encounter with the Living God: The veneration of relics is a communion with the heroes of our Christian faith, asking for their powerful intercession. Many people have reported outstanding blessings and conversions through this ministry, and many have reported healings.

Thanks to Fr. Carlos Martins the director of Treasures of the Church. It is a ministry of evangelization of the Catholic Church. Its purpose is to give people an experience of the living God through an encounter with the relics of his saints in the form of an exposition.

Exposition involves over 150 relics from every period of the Church's history, including St. Joseph, the Twelve Apostles, St. Mary Magdalene, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Maria Goretti, St. Thérèse of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Faustina Kowalska, Pope St. John Paul II, and Bl. Carlo Acutis. The supreme highlight is some of the largest remaining fragments of Wood from the True Cross (the Cross upon which Our Lord died) and a piece of the Veil worn by the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Attendees are encouraged to bring their articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members which may be touched to the reliquaries as a means of intercessory prayer. The Holy Father has issued a special plenary indulgence for all attendees of a Treasures of the Church exposition. This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. Do not miss this opportunity.

Apply now for private school scholarships

Get an average of \$7,000 a year for K-12 education

ST. PETERSBURG – Families seeking more options in their children's education can now apply for the Florida Tax Credit Scholarship and the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options on one application through Step Up For Students. Scholarship amounts vary by grade and county but will average about \$7,000.

Families can apply online at <u>www.stepupforstudents.org</u>.

The Florida Tax Credit Scholarship (FTC), which began in 2002, and the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO), created in 2019, provide learning options for students in grades K-12. Combined this year, they funded over 163,000 students in more than 2,000 private schools statewide.

Dependent children of members of the United States Armed Forces and Florida law enforcement officers may qualify, <u>regardless of household income</u>.

Families who want faith-based education options for their children can choose from one of more than 1,200 faith-based schools in Florida.

"This scholarship gives students the chance to attend the school that is best for them," said Stacy Angier, principal of Abundant Life Christian Academy in Margate, a founding partner school with Step Up. "For the last 20 years, Abundant Life Christian Academy has been fortunate to accept Step Up For Students scholarships and has seen the impact it has had on so many students. With the right environment and necessary support, every student can strive to be their best."

When Karla Collins left a 23-year-career in public schools a decade ago to become head of Victory Christian Academy, she was unfamiliar with the scholarship programs. But she quickly saw the benefits of letting families choose the school that works best for their children.

"I was excited to hear that families could choose a private school for their children if they wanted something different," Collins says. "Step Up For Students has been a positive solution for so many of them! VCA is a family experience because of Step Up."

About Step Up For Students

Step Up For Students, a 501c3 nonprofit based in Jacksonville and St. Petersburg, has awarded more than 1.3 million scholarships since it was founded in 2002. Today, Step Up administers four of the state's K-12 scholarship programs: the donor-supported Florida Tax Credit Scholarship (FTC) and the taxpayer-funded Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO), for low- and middle-income students; the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA, formerly Gardiner); the Reading Scholarship for public school students in grades K-5 with low reading test scores; and the Hope Scholarship for bullied students.



What does the Feast of Ascension celebrate?

Forty days after Jesus' Resurrection, Our Lord ascended into Heaven (Acts 1:6-11). The Catechism of the Catholic Church (paragraph 665) says, "Christ's Ascension marks the definitive entrance of Jesus' humanity into God's heavenly domain, whence he will come again (cf. Acts 1:11); this humanity in the meantime hides him from the eyes of men (cf. Col 3:3)."

Before ascending in the presence of His Apostles, He commissioned them to continue His ministry of redemption, saying, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, to the close of the age." (Mt. 28:18-20)

What does Christ's Ascension mean for us? Humanity on its own does not have access to the "Father's house," to God's life and happiness. Only Christ can open to man such access that we might have confidence that we too shall go where he, our Head and our Source, has preceded us. (CCC 661)
