






## Job Opening: Part-time Receptionist

## NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL: EUCHARISTIC LESSONS

**DID YOU KNOW? According to a Pew study in the fall of 2019, only 30% of Catholics understand the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist.**

As we go through the three year Eucharistic revival, we will be consistently providing lessons about the Eucharist from Sacred Tradition and Sacred Scripture. Let's begin:

### **What is the Eucharist?**

The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. The term "Eucharist" originates from the Greek word *eucharistia*, meaning thanksgiving.



In the celebration of the Eucharist, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and the instrumentality of the priest. The whole Christ is truly present -- body, blood, soul, and divinity -- under the appearances of bread and wine, the glorified Christ who rose from the dead. This is what the Church means when she speaks of the "Real Presence" of Christ in the Eucharist.

### **Where is the Eucharist mentioned in the Bible?**

The Lord Jesus, on the night before he suffered on the cross, shared one last meal with his disciples. During this meal our Savior instituted the sacrament of his Body and Blood. He did this in order to perpetuate the sacrifice of the Cross throughout the ages and to entrust to the Church a memorial of his death and resurrection. The Institution of the Eucharist is written down in the four Gospels below:

Matthew 26:26-30

Mark 14:22-26

Luke 22:14-20

John 6:22-59 (The Bread of Life Discourse)



# FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK



## Happy Fourth of July or Independence Day Weekend!

On July 4, 1776, in the midst of the American Revolution, the Continental Congress meeting in Philadelphia courageously declared the thirteen colonies independent from Great Britain. Tomorrow, 246 years later, we celebrate this Declaration. With all our fellow Americans, we celebrate our freedom on this Independence Day, the Fourth of July.

This Independence Day we celebrate the gift of our freedom and the sacrifices made to earn and keep it. Freedom is a gift from GOD and not the government.

Freedom is a precious gift. A gift that is too easily abused. Freedom is often used as an excuse for people to do whatever they want. However, this is not right. Freedom does not mean we can choose to do whatever we want. After all, there are consequences to our decisions. Freedom comes with responsibility. We have to use our freedom to do what is right. Not just for us, but also for our loved ones and our community.

This weekend's Scriptures are about announcing the Good News. They remind us that announcing the Good News of the Kingdom by words, deeds, and life is not the task of only a few. Rather, it is a task for all baptized Christians.

Imagine for a moment what those early disciples must have felt like as Jesus sends them out on their first mission to announce: "The reign of God is at hand."

He sent them to prepare the towns and villages for his coming. They were to proclaim "peace" everywhere they went. And he gave them power to cure the sick.

Marvelous things must have happened on their journeys because they come back overjoyed with their experience: "Even the demons are subject to us in your name."

Jesus shares their joy, but he warns them: don't get so caught up in the power you have that you forget that you are disciples who have been created anew by placing your faith and trust in me. I am the source of your salvation; any power you have comes from me.

St. Paul learned that early in his ministry. We hear it echoed in his letter to the Galatians: "May I never boast of anything but the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ." This kind of humility is key to the effectiveness of Jesus' disciples.

On this fourth of July, it is appropriate that we take some time to think about our freedom. To thank God for the sacrifices people have made to earn and preserve this precious gift. To thank God for the gift of freedom so we can freely choose to love Him and one another.

## Apply now for private school scholarships

Get an average of \$7,000 a year for K-12 education

ST. PETERSBURG – Families seeking more options in their children’s education can now apply for the Florida Tax Credit Scholarship and the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options on one application through Step Up For Students. Scholarship amounts vary by grade and county but will average about \$7,000.

Families can apply online at [www.stepupforstudents.org](http://www.stepupforstudents.org).

The Florida Tax Credit Scholarship (FTC), which began in 2002, and the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO), created in 2019, provide learning options for students in grades K-12. Combined this year, they funded over 163,000 students in more than 2,000 private schools statewide.

Dependent children of members of the United States Armed Forces and Florida law enforcement officers may qualify, regardless of household income.

Families who want faith-based education options for their children can choose from one of more than 1,200 faith-based schools in Florida.

“This scholarship gives students the chance to attend the school that is best for them,” said Stacy Angier, principal of Abundant Life Christian Academy in Margate, a founding partner school with Step Up. “For the last 20 years, Abundant Life Christian Academy has been fortunate to accept Step Up For Students scholarships and has seen the impact it has had on so many students. With the right environment and necessary support, every student can strive to be their best.”

When Karla Collins left a 23-year-career in public schools a decade ago to become head of Victory Christian Academy, she was unfamiliar with the scholarship programs. But she quickly saw the benefits of letting families choose the school that works best for their children.

“I was excited to hear that families could choose a private school for their children if they wanted something different,” Collins says. “Step Up For Students has been a positive solution for so many of them! VCA is a family experience because of Step Up.”

### About Step Up For Students

Step Up For Students, a 501c3 nonprofit based in Jacksonville and St. Petersburg, has awarded more than 1.3 million scholarships since it was founded in 2002. Today, Step Up administers four of the state’s K-12 scholarship programs: the donor-supported Florida Tax Credit Scholarship (FTC) and the taxpayer-funded Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO), for low- and middle-income students; the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA, formerly Gardiner); the Reading Scholarship for public school students in grades K-5 with low reading test scores; and the Hope Scholarship for bullied students.


