

# NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL: EUCHARISTIC LESSONS

DID YOU KNOW? According to a Pew study in the fall of 2019, only 30% of Catholics understand the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

As we go through the three year Eucharistic revival, we will be consistently providing lessons about the Eucharist from Sacred Tradition and Sacred Scripture. Let's begin:


## Why does Jesus give himself to us as food and drink?

Jesus gives himself to us in the Eucharist as spiritual nourishment because he loves us. God's whole plan for our salvation is directed to our participation in the life of the Trinity: the communion of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Our sharing in this life begins with our Baptism, when by the power of the Holy Spirit we are joined to Christ, thus becoming adopted sons and daughters of the Father. It is strengthened and

increased in Confirmation in which there is an outpouring of the Holy Spirit with its fruits and gifts. It is then nourished and deepened through our participation in the Eucharist. By eating



the Body and drinking the Blood of Christ in the Eucharist, we become united to the person of Christ through his humanity. "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him" (Jn 6:56). In being united to the humanity of Christ, we are at the same time united to his divinity; just like how we nourish our physical bodies with food and drink, our souls also are nourished with spiritual food and drink. Our mortal and corruptible natures are transformed by being joined to the source of life.



## Is the Eucharist a symbol?

The transformed bread and wine are truly the Body and Blood of Christ and are **not merely symbols**. When Christ said "This is my body" and "This is my blood," the bread and wine are transubstantiated. Though the bread and wine appear the same to our human faculties, they are actually the real body and blood of Jesus.

# FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

## The weekend readings exhort us to listen to the Word of God.

St. Francis de Sales has much to say about actively listening to the Word of God. Here are a few of his thoughts: Martha was anxious and upset about many things while Mary had no care but to listen to Jesus' words. Our Lord reproved Martha because she was anxious, not because of her care for His needs. She had mixed motives. On the one hand, she desired to serve Our Lord. On the other hand, in busying herself with many tasks, she was anxious



to appear as the perfect hostess. Since Jesus wanted Martha to listen to Him as Mary did, one dish well prepared would have sufficed to meet His needs.



Our Lord makes it very clear that we must not only hear His words but also listen to them with the intention of making them profitable to ourselves. To profit from the word of God, we must let ourselves be moved by it in the depths of our heart. It is by listening to God's word with the heart that we receive good inspirations. The heart comes alive and ever gains new strength and vigor.

However, it is difficult to listen to the Word of God with our hearts when our hearts are filled

with anxiety. God is full of care for His creatures, but with peace and tranquility. Yet, our care tends to be anxious. Birds stay caught in nets because they flutter wildly. So, it is when we desire to escape an anxiety. Resolve to do nothing that your desire insists on until your mind has regained peace. Gently put yourself in God's hands. Try calmly to moderate your desire according to reason. Our life consists in the today, this present moment in which we are living. Use with care all that is given you. Be free of all other care and leave the rest to Our Lord, who takes



tender care of us and will surely provide sufficiently for your needs when you listen to His words and inspirations.

# Apply now for private school scholarships

Get an average of \$7,000 a year for K-12 education

May 3, 2022



ST. PETERSBURG – Families seeking more options in their children's education can now apply for the Florida Tax Credit Scholarship and the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options on one application through Step Up For Students. Scholarship amounts vary by grade and county but will average about \$7,000.

Families can apply online at www.stepupforstudents.org.

The Florida Tax Credit Scholarship (FTC), which began in 2002, and the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO), created in 2019, provide learning options for students in grades K-12. Combined this year, they funded over 163,000 students in more than 2,000 private schools statewide.

Dependent children of members of the United States Armed Forces and Florida law enforcement officers may qualify, <u>regardless of household income</u>.

Families who want faith-based education options for their children can choose from one of more than 1,200 faith-based schools in Florida.

"This scholarship gives students the chance to attend the school that is best for them," said Stacy Angier, principal of Abundant Life Christian Academy in Margate, a founding partner school with Step Up. "For the last 20 years, Abundant Life Christian Academy has been fortunate to accept Step Up For Students scholarships and has seen the impact it has had on so many students. With the right environment and necessary support, every student can strive to be their best."

When Karla Collins left a 23-year-career in public schools a decade ago to become head of Victory Christian Academy, she was unfamiliar with the scholarship programs. But she quickly saw the benefits of letting families choose the school that works best for their children.

"I was excited to hear that families could choose a private school for their children if they wanted something different," Collins says. "Step Up For Students has been a positive solution for so many of them! VCA is a family experience because of Step Up."

#### **About Step Up For Students**

Step Up For Students, a 501c3 nonprofit based in Jacksonville and St. Petersburg, has awarded more than 1.3 million scholarships since it was founded in 2002. Today, Step Up administers four of the state's K-12 scholarship programs: the donor-supported Florida Tax Credit Scholarship (FTC) and the taxpayer-funded Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO), for low- and middle-income students; the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA, formerly Gardiner); the Reading Scholarship for public school students in grades K-5 with low reading test scores; and the Hope Scholarship for bullied students.




