

ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT FISCAL YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2022

Dear Parishioners,


The 2021-2022 Pastoral Year at our beloved Holy Spirit Community has been a year full of blessings. I am so very thankful for the outpouring of love and support that I have received from this community of believers. I am very grateful for the Christ-centered commitment, stewardship, and discipleship of our congregation!

The accompanying Annual Report represents the financial condition of our Parish for the year ending June 30, 2022. This annual report is presented by the Parish Finance Council which provides financial oversight and advice to me your Pastor on money matters for the Parish. I hope that it will help you understand how your contributions and gifts to our Parish are used and accounted for and will encourage your continued generosity.

CHURCH INCOME AND EXPENSE

Income for the church was higher this fiscal year compared to both the budget and to last year. Attendance at mass has been improving and the generosity of our parishioners is greatly appreciated.


Expenses for our Church were higher than last year primarily due to support of the school as they received COVID payroll support last year. We continue to exercise fiscal control over our costs in these times of inflation.



Not included in these numbers are the projects we completed with donations for specific purposes including the Life Garden in memory of Monsignor James Heslin which enhances our campus and the completely renovated Boys and Girls restrooms in our school.

The repaving and restriping of the church parking lot was the major improvement this year and was paid from our reserve fund and is not reflected in expenses above.

This is where the money was spent this year.



FAMILY LIFE CENTER (FLC)

Donations received this year were 109,024 vs. budget of 72,000.

Expense for our FLC includes mortgage payments (principal and interest) of 5,771 per month or 69,252 annually. It also includes 16,450 annual property insurance. All other costs are included in our Church expense.

We currently owe 546,634 on the mortgage, While the three-year Capital Campaign has concluded, we still have the mortgage to pay so we encourage everyone to continue to support our FLC with your contributions.

I give thanks to God for the generosity of so many in this period of uncertainty that enabled our parish to end the year on a solid financial footing. I am humbled to be your local spiritual leader and pledge my continued efforts to be found worthy of this honor. Despite all the difficulties, our parish continues to be vibrant in all corners of our ministries. Religious education, social outreach, faith formation and our liturgies are very much alive and well. I am thankful for all our wonderful leaders who have shown their zeal and creativity. To that end I say, thank you, thank you, thank you and Praise Be to Jesus Christ!

In the interest of transparency and accountability, we provide this summary financial information to you. Parishioners may always ask to review our audited financial statements during normal business hours. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact me, or Nick Winiewicz our Parish Finance Council chairman or Jim Davis our Business Manager.

I kindly ask you to continue to support all our ministries with your time, talent, and treasure.




