

# FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

**RESPECT LIFE SUNDAY:** As Catholics, one of the terms that we often hear used in parish and church circles is "Respect Life." Since October 1972, the Catholic Church in the United States has celebrated (the first Sunday in the month of October) Respect Life Sunday as a way to call Catholics across the nation to remember the sanctity of life in a world where the dignity of life is not always respected.



Respect for human life is a fundamental tenet of our Christian faith laid down for us in the very beginning of the Scriptures in the book of Genesis. This basic respect for human life is further shown to us through the example of Jesus, who often fought for the rights of the downtrodden and forgotten of society. He often challenged those who were in a position of authority to help the weak and powerless, and chastised them when they did not.

When we hear the term "Respect Life" we often think immediately of the abortion controversy of pro-life vs. pro-choice. The pro-life position is often inaccurately portrayed as being merely anti-abortion, not caring about women and their children past the time of birth. Many are completely unaware of the countless ministries and agencies in the Church that support women, children, and their families throughout the stages of life.



Diocese of St. Augustine Office of Human Life and Dignity tirelessly provides ministry to the Unborn, against Abortion, Healing after Abortion, Special Needs, Reproductive Loss and Miscarriage, End of Life Issues - Physician Assisted Suicide, Death Penalty- Prison Ministry, and Human Trafficking.

Catholics must give a clear and united witness in both word and action. We pray that our elected officials will enact laws and policies that promote and protect the most vulnerable among us. Our thoughts are with the little ones whose lives have been taken. We mourn their loss, and we entrust their souls to God. Our hearts are also with every woman and man who has suffered grievously from abortion; we pray for their healing, and we pledge our continued compassion and support. As a Church, we need to serve those who face difficult pregnancies and surround them with love.

Get involved. Bring your talents and questions to the parish respect life team and learn the issues, then join with them, in proclaiming the sanctity of all human life. Visit the DOSA website or contact the office of Human Life and Dignity to learn about the specific efforts underway to bring about a Culture of Life in our parishes, diocese, and communities.
