

# **CHURCH FOYER AREA RENOVATION**

After 30 years we will be renovating and updating our church Lobby (gathering area), Brides Room, Priest Sacristy, and Restrooms in brides' room, priest sacristy, and cry room. We will be replacing floors, cabinets, plumbing, and painting walls and ceiling.

The construction will **begin Monday 11/7** with very little disruption for daily mass except <u>we will have to use side</u> <u>entrances to enter and exit the church during this week</u>.

There will be no disruption for the weekend masses.

Beginning Monday, 11/14 through Friday, 11/18 daily Mass will be held in the Family Life Center. We will keep you updated weekly. It is our goal to complete the majority of this project by Thanksgiving.

Adoration will be cancelled weeks of 11/14 and 11/21. Adoration will begin again on 11/28.

**Togetherness Tuesdays will be cancelled for the month of November** and will resume on December 6.



# FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

**FULLNESS OF LIFE**: Today we are reminded that there is life after death - a resurrected life that will transform our whole existence.

Human beings have always believed in some kind of life after death – in Sheol or Hades in some dark lifeless kind of existence for everyone. There may be no grounds for this belief except that we can't see how everything just finishes when we die.



The Jews gradually thought differently. They believed in God, who was faithful to his promises as they saw in Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob and throughout their history and particularly in Moses and the Promised Land.

In the persecutions some 160 years before Christ as we read in the second book of Maccabees many Jews heroically died for their God. And so, the belief in the resurrection arose. God would give life to his faithful people. They didn't think in terms of soul but in terms of the person. The person would live.



Some Sadducees, the questioners of Jesus tried to ridicule this idea. It would be convenient if the life 'in the land of the spirits' is the same for all. We can make the most of this life in every way we can.

But Jesus talks of those 'who are judged worthy of a place in the resurrection'. For those who love him 'no eye has seen, no ear has heard, nor has it entered into the heart of man to imagine what God has prepared'.

However, we know that those who live in Jesus now will become like him. The Risen Christ is our hope and expectation. Jesus is the model for graced human living. That is the gift we now share. He shows us how to live our new life in a way that gives witness to our dignity - a dignity that has been given to us by the merciful grace of God.

St. Paul in his second letter to Thessalonians summarizes how a believer lives: a believer's life is a life ruled by God's love and the constancy shown by Jesus. Jesus knew that his Father loved him. He returned this love by doing his Father's will.

That is how we are urged to live - trusting in God's love for us and making every effort to understand our Father's will for us today and then choosing to do his will to the best of our ability. Living this way each day with the strength of God's grace is how we can respond to the gift of God's life within us. It also prepares us for the fullness of life promised us when we die.

# The Nation's Report Card: Catholic Schools a Bright Spot Amidst Dismal News

On October 24, the U.S. Department of Education's National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) released the latest results from the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP), scores which fell to levels not seen in two decades, and which Education Secretary Miguel Cardona called "appalling" and "unacceptable."

Catholic-school students now boast the nation's highest scale scores on all four NAEP tests. The average score among fourth-graders in Catholic schools was 233, 17 points higher than the national public-school average, or about 1½ grade levels ahead. In eighth-grade reading, the average score for Catholic school students was 279, 20 points higher than the national public-school average, or about two grade levels ahead.






