



PREPARE THE WAY: Last weekend after all the Aasses we had Advent Wreath making event. It was an amazing event to witness the number of families participating and enjoying the process of making an Advent Wreath and take it home. No doubt that it was a faith filled time while having lots of fun with the family. I would like to express my sincere gratitude to Dwayne and Allison Stanton for organizing the entire program. Thank you all for participating!

The Advent Wreath is a long-standing Christian Tradition that makes the four weeks preceding the celebration of Christmas. The four candles which are lit on each of the four Sundays of advent represent the four virtues that Jesus teaches us: hope, love, joy, and peace. While the violet candles stand hope, peace, and love; the rose candle represents joy and the white candle in the middle represents Christ's purity and love.

The first candle is called the Prophecy Candle, the second Bethlehem Candle, the third the Shepherd's Candle, the fourth the Angel's Candle and the fifth candle in the middle is Christmas Candle. In brief, they remind us of God's promise of our salvation through Jesus Christ.



As we enter the second week of Advent, we hear the voice the one in the wilderness, John the Baptist. We experience Saint John the Baptist urging us to "repent, prepare the way of the Lord, and make straight his paths."

Saint Francis de Sales comments on this passage: "Make straight the paths of the Lord." Roads that twist and turn too much, only fatigue and mislead travelers. Our life contains many tortuous ways that we must make straight for our Lord's coming.

First, we must correct our mixed intentions and have only one, that of pleasing God by changing our hearts. Like the mariner who always keeps his eye on the needle of the compass as he steers his boat, we too must always have our eyes open to penitence, that is, a change of heart.

Let us therefore prepare ourselves to receive the Lord of peace, joy and love into our lives, our families, our communities and above all, into our hearts.


