




Thanks to everyone who participated in the BloodDrive last weekend. We had 16 participants and 13 pints donated. Thanks to everyone you are truly saving lives.

SCAM ALERT

Based on recent events, please be aware of new email, text, call and social media scams.

If you receive a message or email from Fr. Amar asking if you are available and can send him money or gift cards.

PLEASE IGNORE!!! This is a scam!!!



Common signs of scams are incorrect email addresses or unfamiliar caller id locations (the proper ones for the parish are found in the bulletin and on the myParishApp Directory); scammers are now able to change caller id numbers to pretend to be a known number as well. Inconsistent or improper tone of language are also signs of scammers. Social media scams will use official photos but have low number of followers and posts will be irrelevant to the person.

Please be careful and feel free to call the church office to double check any inquiries.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

“Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord.”

How do we “follow the law of the LORD” so as to live well? Saint Francis de Sales explains: First, we must purify all our intentions as far as we can. We must make a firm purpose to use the day well with the intention of living as best we can in conformity with God's ways. Anticipate what tasks, transactions and occasions for serving God you may meet today. What temptations will you be exposed to, such as anger, self-centered love, or some other irregularities? Carefully prepare yourself to avoid, resist and overcome whatever might hinder you from authentically living Jesus.




Saint Francis de Sales elaborates: To follow the law of the Lord, first make a holy resolution to grow in the love Jesus exemplified. To prepare yourself to put this resolution into practice, ask our Savior to help you make the best use of the means available to you to grow in holy love and serve Him.

Admit that you alone cannot carry out your decision to avoid evil and do the good that God desires of you. Hold your heart in your hands and offer it with your good desires to Our Savior. Ask Him to take your heart under His protection and strengthen it so to grow in His authentic love.

To follow the law of the Lord, train yourself to pray. Receive the sacraments often. As you perform the important tasks of your vocation, never forget to practice humility, gentleness, patience and simplicity, virtues that grow like flowers at the foot of the Cross.

As you care for your family with all the diligence required, bring these souls to love God by infusing good inspirations into their hearts. Great opportunities to serve God rarely present themselves but little ones are frequent.
