


ROSARY MINISTRY— PEOPLE NEEDED

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In the midst of so many voices in the world, we are invited to cultivate a habit of listening to the voice of God as we go about doing our daily chores. To be listening is to remain open to the unfolding of the mystery of God's will and purpose for us...to be open to God's self-revelation as we encounter people and situations and many events in the universe....

St. Augustine had a listening problem. He didn't listen to his mother and didn't listen to the inner voice either. Finally, he proclaimed... Late have I loved you, Beauty so ancient and so new, late have I loved you! Lo, you were within, but I outside, seeking there for you, and upon the shapely things you have made I rushed headlong – I, misshapen. You were with me, but I was not with you. They held me back far from you, those things which would have no being, were they not in you. You called, shouted, broke through my deafness; you flared, blazed, banished my blindness; you lavished your fragrance, I gasped; and now I pant for you; I tasted you, and now I hunger and thirst; you touched me, and I burned for your peace. **(St. Augustine)**

Having breathed the fragrance of God's Truth and Beauty, he longs for God and burns for the peace that only the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ can provide. To be listening to the voice of God is to remain open to the unfolding of the mystery of God's will and purpose for us and respond promptly and generously.

Be sure to take a few still moments during the week.

Bless yourself with stillness! Be Still Moment - Allow yourself to be still for a moment. I have learned silence from the talkative, toleration from the intolerant, and kindness from the unkind; yet, strange, I am ungrateful to those teachers. (Khalil Gibran)

I only know them by name."

Jesus tells us. I am the Good Shepherd and I know my sheep. I call them by name, and they follow me!

Pray for each other... Let us be close to each other in spirit and prayer as we continue our journey through life with all its joyful moments as well as moments not so joyful. Be faithful to your calling! All you do may not be successful in your eyes or in the eyes of others. The real success lies in your fidelity to who you are and what you have come to know as your calling. Just be faithful and be joyful! God bless you and your families.




