Come join us in our annual rosary procession around the church grounds at 10AM. The procession will end inside the church and Mass will immediately follow.





## OCTOBER IS RESPECT LIFE MONTH

### Radical solidarity

This year, nationwide effort is sponsored by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) to help Catholics understand, value, and become engaged with building a culture that cherishes every human life.

This year's Respect Life theme from the USCCB is **Radical Solidarity**, which invites Catholics to be deeply transformed by Christ's example of love. We are called to embrace human life, come alongside the vulnerable, and move in compassion to contribute to a culture of life. As Archbishop Gustavo stated in his homily at January's Mass for Life: "A greater respect for life – from the womb to the tomb and at every stage between conception and natural death – is only possible through a greater and more perfect love of God and all people. No one may be excluded from our love, as no one is excluded from the love of God." Let us with one voice continue to speak the language of love and affirm the right of every human being to have the value of his or her life, from conception to natural death, respected to the highest degree.

At the National Prayer Breakfast in Washington, DC, on February 5, 1994, St. Teresa of Calcutta said:

"I feel that the greatest destroyer of peace today is abortion because it is a war against the child, a direct killing of the innocent child". So, abortion just leads to more abortions. Any country that accepts abortion is not teaching its people to love, but to use any violence to get what they want. This is why the greatest destroyer of love and peace is abortion. She concluded her speech with words of hope, and a reminder that we are called to use our freedom for higher purposes than taking away the right to live.

"If we remember that God loves us, and that we can love others as He loves us, then America can become a sign of peace for the world. From here, a sign of care for the weakest of the weak — the unborn child — must go out to the world. If you become a burning light of justice and peace in the world, then really you will be true to what the founders of this country stood for. God bless you!" St. Teresa of Calcutta.

## HOLY SPIRIT CATHOLIC SCHOOL: A BLUE RIBBON SCHOOL



The list of 353 National Blue Ribbon Schools for 2023 was recently released by the U.S. Department of Education. They include 16 schools in the state of Florida and only 1 private school which was Queen of Peace Academy in Gainesville. They become the 8th school in the Diocese of St. Augustine to achieve this national recognition.

Of the 40 private schools in America to be named Blue Ribbon Schools of Excellence this year, 34 are Catholic schools.

In 2022, there were only 24 private schools in the country that met the criteria for this award and only 2 (not 16) schools in the entire state of Florida. St. John Vianney High School and Holy Spirit School in Jacksonville.
