# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



## All Saints Day

"He began to teach them..."

In her book entitled Saint Francis de Sales and the Protestants (in which she examines his missionary activity in the Chablais, one of the most seminal periods in the life of the "Gentleman Saint"), author Ruth Kleinman wrote: "Saintliness is hard to practice, but it is even more difficult to describe." A notable exception to this dictum is the words we hear proclaimed today in the Gospel of Matthew on this Solemnity of All Saints. Jesus describes saintliness simply and succinctly. It is about living a life of Beatitude:

- Sainthood are those who mourn, i.e., those who refuse to harden their hearts when faced with the needs of others.
- Sainthood are those who show mercy, i.e., those who are willing to forgo old hurts and to forgive others from their hearts.
- Sainthood are those who are poor in spirit, i.e., those who experience everything as a gift and who demonstrate their gratitude through their willingness to share what they have (regardless of how ordinary or extraordinary) with others.
- Sainthood are the pure of heart, i.e., those who avoid artificiality and pretense and who have the courage to be their true, authentic selves.
- Sainthood are the meek, i.e., those who know that power isn't demonstrated by taking from others but about giving to others. It's not about doing to others but about doing for/with others.
- Sainthood are the peacemakers, i.e., those who bring people together rather than drive them apart.
- Sainthood are those who hunger and thirst for what is right, i.e., those for whom doing good comes with the same frequency and urgency as the need to eat and drink.
- Sainthood are those persecuted for doing what is right, i.e., those who are willing to stand up for what is right regardless of the cost(s) incurred.

Sainthood? To be sure, it is hard work. But with the grace of God – and the support of one another – it is doable!

## All Souls Day

The souls of the just are in the hands of God..."

In one of his pamphlets that was later published in a broader collection entitled The Catholic Controversy, Francis de Sales wrote:

"We maintain that we may pray for the faithful departed, and that the prayers and good works of the living greatly relieve them and are profitable to them for this reason: that all those who die in the grace of God – and consequently, in the number of the elect – do not go to Paradise at the very first moment, but many go to Purgatory...from which our prayers and good works can help and serve to deliver them."

So, Francis de Sales reminds us that at the end of the day it is the life and death of Jesus Christ that purifies our souls, whether in this life or in the next. To that end, whether it's the just or the unjust, whether it's in this world or the next, we are all in the hands of God. As children of God – be it in this world or the next – we are a communion of saints. We are in this together!

## Catholic Halloween... Let's Be Catholic!

Halloween is approaching and how can we celebrate as Catholics?

It is beautiful to remember that we can recognize and enjoy simple earthly pleasures. The material world is a gift from God. We can find our balance in the world by following the words of **St. Paul**: "Finally, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is gracious, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things" (Phil 4:8)


Halloween can bring out the extreme: spooks with ghouls and ghosts; sorcery and black magic, with witches, wizards, vampires, and zombies; and the scary, bloody, and gruesome. But these are not universal. **As Catholics we can seek to find the middle ground. We are given an opportunity to embrace good, clean, and innocent fun and to give an example of true festivity. Let us dress up like saints and be model witnesses to the secular culture which has overtaken our family traditions and customs. Let's Be Catholic!**

**As we enter the triduum of Halloween, All Saints and All Souls, let us remember as we keep our balance in the world to celebrate Halloween as Catholics!**
