

SUNDAY OBLIGATION AND 2023/2024 CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEARS MASSES

Our Christmas Eve and New Years Masses fall on Sundays this year. **These evening Masses**<u>DO NOT</u> count as your Sunday obligation; the evening Masses listed above count for Christmas and New Years (Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary), respectively.

The Sunday Obligation on December 24 celebrates the Fourth Sunday of Advent during the day. Our regular Mass times on Saturday (Dec. 23) 5PM, Sunday (Dec. 24) 8:30AM and Sunday (Dec. 24) 11AM will count for this obligation. These Masses count for the Fourth Sunday of Advent and **NOT** for Christmas.

The Sunday Obligation on December 31 celebrates the Feast of the Holy Family during the day. Our regular Mass times on Saturday (Dec. 30) 5PM, Sunday (Dec. 31) 8:30AM and Sunday (Dec. 31) 11AM will count for this obligation. These Masses count for the Feast of the Holy Family and **NOT** for New Years Day (Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary).

A Guide to





BEFORE YOU GO

Examine your conscience, that is, reflect on what sins you have committed. To guide you, take an "Examination of Conscience" guide from the gathering area or just Google one. Preparing to receive the sacrament helps us open ourselves to God's grace and mercy.



INTRODUCTION

When you come before the priest whether sitting face to face or behind the screen, begin by making the Sign of the Cross, and continue by saying, "Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. It has been (how long) since my last confession. My sins are..."



CONFESSION

List the sins you've committed that came to mind during your examination of conscience or any that also come to mind during this time. Don't be too general ("I haven't been a good person"), but also don't be too detailed (you don't need to tell the whole story of how a sin came about). If you're not sure, ask the priest. Remember that this is not professional counseling, but the sacrament of Confession.



PENANCE

The priest will then give you something to do or pray as your penance. Penance is your response to God's mercy. You'll have to remember what this is and do it after the confession is over, so pay attention.



ACT OF CONTRITION

The priest will then ask you to pray out loud the "Act of Contrition": My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.



ABSOLUTION

After you pray the Act of Contrition, the priest will extend his hands and pray the Prayer of Absolution. Here, the priest acts in the person of Christ, so as to forgive your sins. Remember it's still God that is forgiving your sins, but he priest acts in the person of Christ at this moment.



CONCLUSION

The priest will then say some conclusion such as "Go in peace," and you can respond, "Thanks be to God." Don't forget to do your penance. If it is saying certain prayers, the best is to do it right away before you leave the church or before you forget.

These demons – while not necessarily limited to this list – could include:

- Anxieties
 Grudges
 Bitterness
 Resentment
 Old Hurts

 Ingratitude
 Presumption

The Kingdom of heaven is at hand! Why not make more room in your life for the Word-Made-Flesh by driving out our demons through some heavy-duty spiritual house-cleaning on December 10th, at 5:00 PM in the Holy Spirit catholic Church? Let bring ourselves and immerse in the Ocean of His Mercy, the Most Merciful Jesus, whose very nature is to have compassion on us and to forgive us and leads us to His infinite goodness and from the treasury of His Mercy.

I pray that you take advantage of our parish Advent Reconciliation on December 10th, at

5:00 PM in the Church. Have a blessed Advent!

CONGRATULATIONS HOLY SPIRIT CATHOLIC SCHOOL!
