

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

So many activities took place in our parish last week. But beginning this week we have activities and events that relate to the Lenten Journey and Spiritual Renewal, both individually and collectively as a parish community. ## 10 TIPS FOR MAKING LENT MORE MEANINGFUL

- Slow Down** – Set aside 10 minutes a day for silent prayer or meditation. It will revitalize your body and your spirit...feel free do this in your car right before you walk into work.
- Consume a spiritual media**– Download a Catholic app like Laudate or iBreviary to help in prayer, listen to a scriptural podcast like "The Bible in a Year with Fr. Mike Schmitz" or watch a YouTube video from Ascension Press or Word on Fire with Bishop Barron's homilies. Technology can be a tool to help your faith.
- Be kind** – Go out of your way to do something nice for someone else every day even in small way.
- Get involved** – Attend a Lenten event at Holy Spirit or volunteer for something for a few weeks.
- Volunteer at your parish or somewhere else**– Whether it's the parish fish fry, cleaning the church or helping with the food drive, it will give you a chance to help others.
- Reach out** – Call a family member or friend you haven't talked to in a while just to chat or check-up.
- Pray** – Start off in small steps, then increase your prayer little by little.
- Tune out** – Try not using your phone, TV and computer for a day or decrease your time on them.
- Clean out closets** – Donate gently used items to the local clothes closet.
- Donate** – Decide how you can help by sending money, clothing or supplies for St. Vincent de Paul.


