Who is eligible to be commissioned as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion?

- Those who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- Those serious in the practice of the Catholic Faith, dedicated to prayer and Eucharist.
- If married, must be in a Catholic sacramental marriage.
- Must be registered in Holy Spirit Catholic Church and has a desire to answer the call of Christ to serve others.

THE 3 PILLARS OF LENT

PRAYER



What is it?

Prayer is the raising of one's mind and heart to God or having a conversation with God where one can praise, ask, give thanks or pray for others.

How can we live it?

- Meditation of Holy Scripture, writings of the saints, fathers of the Church, spiritual authors, etc.
- Receiving the sacraments
- Daily acts of consecration or personal devotion
- Attending retreats, spiritual exercises, etc.

Examples for Lent:

- Prayer the Stations of the Cross
- Daily reflection of the Passion of Christ readings
- Attend Mass during the week other than Sunday
- Go to confession
- Reflect on the faith by watching Catholic YouTube videos such as on Ascension Presents, Word on Fire, etc.
- Learn about the faith by listening to a Scripture podcast or Catholic topics podcast
- Increase personal prayer

FASTING



What is it?

Fasting is the restriction of consumption so as to grow in gratitude for what God has provided and to further focus on God.

How can we live it?

- Moderation in eating and drinking
- Reducing expenses on material things or luxurious things or events
- Abstaining from the internet, TV or other forms of entertainment for certain periods of time
- Fasting from slothfulness, gluttony, lust, gossip or other vices

Examples for Lent:

- Offer some food or drink that you like for Lent
- Fast from phone use for a day or weekend
- Give up one of your social media apps for Lent
- Avoid cursing, gossiping or unnecessary speech

ALMSGIVING



What is it?

Almsgiving is the act of donating money, service or goods to the poor or performing other acts of charity.

How can we live it?

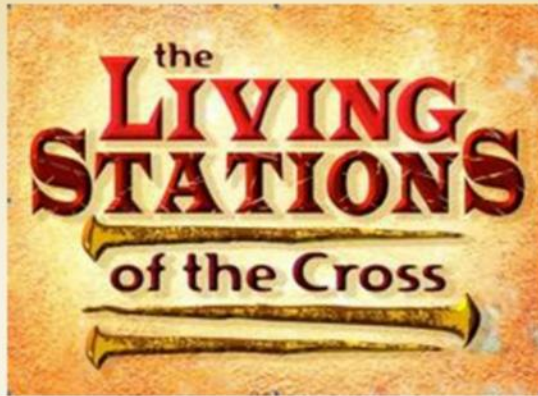
- Dedicate time to your family, studies or work
- Helping others through service or material goods
- Doing an act of charity
- Be generous with your virtues and gifts that God has given you

Examples for Lent:

- Donating food or clothing to St. Vincent de Paul
- Offer your time in a ministry or event at the parish like the Fish Fry
- Dedicate your time at home to help another family member with a chore
- Listen to someone's story with empathy

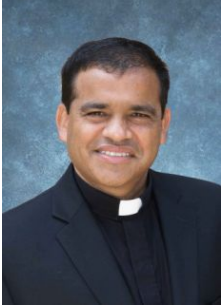

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



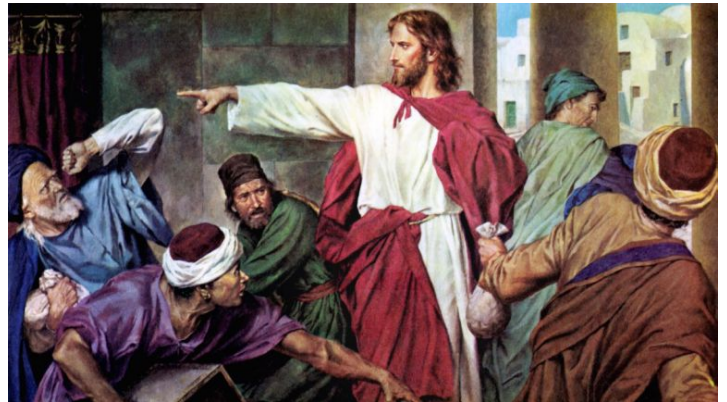
Dear Sisters and Brothers,

“My Father’s House” ...

The temple of God turned into a marketplace! How outrageous! It must have started with something small. A shepherd coming up to sell a lamb, an elderly woman wanting to earn some money by selling doves..., and it grew from there. So much so that the author of the Song of Songs cried out, "Catch us the foxes, the little foxes that damage the vineyards; for our vineyards are in bloom!" (Song 2:15). But who paid any attention? The temple courtyard resembled a day at the fair.

We too are a temple of God. If we do not watch out for the little foxes —pride, sloth, envy, slander, anger, resentment, gossip, and so many disguises of selfishness— they sneak in and spoil everything. Therefore, the Lord warns us, "What I say to you, I say to all: 'Watch!'" (Mk 13:37).

Let us be vigilant, so that sloth does not invade our conscience: "The inability to recognize guilt is the most dangerous form of spiritual dullness imaginable, because it makes people incapable of improvement" (Pope Benedict XVI).



To watch? – try to do it every night. Have I offended anyone? Are my intentions upright? Am I willing to always and in everything do God's will? But at this hour, I am tired, and sleep overtakes me.

Lord Jesus Christ, you who know me thoroughly, you who know well what is inside the heart of each person; make me aware of my faults, give me strength and a share of this zeal of yours and open wide the door of your Father's house and you bid us to enter confidently so that we may worship you with 'Reverence and Awe'. Help me to draw near to your throne of mercy with gratitude and joy.

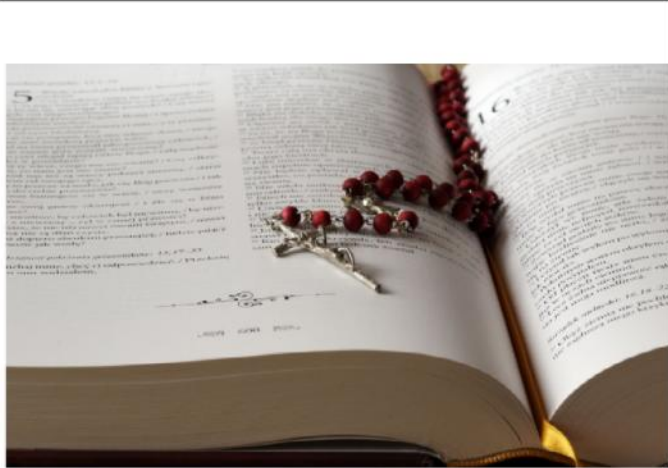

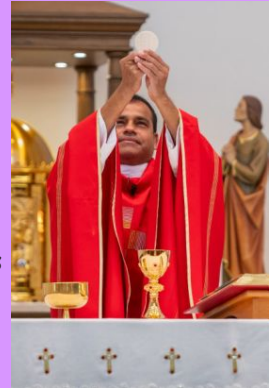

TWELVE BIBLICAL REASONS FOR WANTING TO SPEND ONE HOUR WITH JESUS IN THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

1. He is really there! **"I myself am the living bread come down from heaven."** (Jn 6:35)
2. Day and night Jesus dwells in the Blessed Sacrament because of his Infinite love for you! **"Behold I will be with you always even to the end of the world," because "I have loved you with an everlasting love, and constant is my affection for you."** (Mt 28:20; Jer 31:3)
3. The specific way that Jesus asks you to love him in return is to spend one quiet hour with him in the Blessed Sacrament. **"Where your treasure is, there is your heart..." "Could you not watch one hour with me?"** (Mt 6:21; 26:40)
4. When you look upon the Sacred Host, you look upon Jesus, the Son of God. **"Indeed, this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks upon the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life. Him I will raise up on the last day."** (Jn 6:40)
5. Each moment that you spend in His Eucharistic Presence will increase his divine life within you and deepen your personal relationship and friendship with him. **"I have come that you may have life, and have it more abundantly." "I am the vine and you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him shall bear much fruit because without me, you can do nothing."** (Jn 15:5)
6. Each hour you spend with Jesus will deepen his divine peace in your heart. **"Come to me all of you who are weary and find life burdensome and I will refresh you..." "Cast all of you anxieties upon the one who cares for you..." "My Peace is My Gift to you."** (Mt 11:28; Pt 5:7; Jn 14:17)
7. Jesus will give you all the graces you need to be happy! **"The Lamb on the throne will shepherd them. He will lead them to the springs of life-giving water."** (Rev 7:17)
8. Jesus is infinitely deserving of our unceasing thanksgiving and adoration for all he has done for our salvation. **"Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive honor, glory and praise."** (Rev. 5:12)
9. For peace in our country! **"When my people humble themselves and seek my presence... I will revive their land."** (2Chr 7:14)
10. Each hour you spend with Jesus on earth will leave your soul everlastingly more beautiful and glorious in heaven! **"They who humble themselves shall be exalted..." "All of us, gazing on the Lord's glory with unveiled faces, are being transformed from glory to glory into his very image."** (Lk 18:14; 2Cor 3:18)
11. Jesus will bless you, your family and the whole world for this hour of faith you spend with Him in the Blessed Sacrament. **"Blessed are they who do not see and yet believe..." "Faith can move mountains..." "What is needed is trust..." "Behold I come to make all things new."** (Jn 20:29; Mk 11:23; Mk 5:36; Rev 21:5)

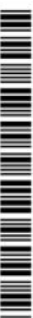
