



# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

## GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Today we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday and what this means to all of us who follow, Jesus, the Good Shepherd? St. Francis de Sales reminds us that we are all shepherds who must tend our sheep:


Our Good Shepherd gathers us all around Himself to keep us always under His most holy protection. But we too are shepherds and have a flock to attend. Our flock is our desires, feelings, and emotions. We must keep watch over this spiritual flock, by learning from Jesus how to govern ourselves.

Since we easily mismanage ourselves, Our Good Shepherd wants us to give up such self-management except to consent and follow His Will. He desires what is best for our wholeness. Following in the footsteps of the Good Shepherd, we learn how to direct, to govern and put our desires, feelings, and emotions in order, so that they conform to God's goodness. What could be more pleasing to this Divine Shepherd than to bring to Him our love so that He may purify them? Holy love is our first desire. True love is accomplished when we live no longer according to our own willful desires, but according to the inspirations and promptings of Our Savior.

Our Shepherd tenderly nourishes us with an incomprehensible love. He died in love, by love, and for love. To bring us life, He suffered death. What remains for us? We ought to consecrate every moment of our life to the divine love of our Savior's death that opened us up to eternal life. That is, we must bring to fruition all our works, all our actions and all our thoughts so that God's glory may shine through them. How happy we will be if we remain in the Shepherd's presence, faithfully bringing His reign in our midst!

As a climax to a prayer that is continually offered throughout the Church, it affirms the primacy of faith and grace in all that concerns vocations to the priesthood and to the consecrated life. While appreciating all vocations, the Church concentrates its attention this day on vocations to the ordained ministries (priesthood and diaconate), consecrated life in all its forms (male and female religious life, societies of apostolic life, consecrated virginity, secular institutes), and to the missionary life. Please pray that young men and women hear and respond generously to the Lord's call to serve Him and to serve God's People.



## HOLY SPIRIT CATHOLIC SCHOOL: A BLUE RIBBON SCHOOL



The list of 353 National Blue Ribbon Schools for 2023 was recently released by the U.S. Department of Education. They include 16 schools in the state of Florida and only 1 private school which was Queen of Peace Academy in Gainesville. They become the 8th school in the Diocese of St. Augustine to achieve this national recognition.

Of the 40 private schools in America to be named Blue Ribbon Schools of Excellence this year, 34 are Catholic schools.

In 2022, there were only 24 private schools in the country that met the criteria for this award and only 2 (not 16) schools in the entire state of Florida. St. John Vianney High School and Holy Spirit School in Jacksonville.



### Jacksonville University Alumni Spotlight - Dr. John Luciano '83, '85, '91

Dr. John Luciano '83,'85, & '91 will be retiring this June after a 40-year career in Education in the Jacksonville community in both public and private schools. John was twice named a Teacher of the Year at two Duval County schools and was a finalist for the Rotary Duval Teacher of the Year. As Principal of Holy Spirit Catholic School, Dr. Luciano led the school's efforts to be named a National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence in 2022.

Holy Spirit Catholic School has received this honor of becoming a Florida Purple Star School.

This designation is given to only those schools who have consistently proven to be welcoming and accommodating to military personnel and their children. 
