





FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

"Remain in me, as I remain in you."

Jesus insists in the gospel that a personal, intimate relationship with him is essential if we are to bear fruit as his disciples. As branches need a vine to bear fruit, we need Jesus. Jesus is very clear: "Without me, you can do nothing." The opposite is also true: with Jesus, we can do everything. Jesus reveals his great desire for us: "Remain in me, as I remain in you." Our efforts to remain in Jesus each day give glory to our Father.

One of the ways we remain in Jesus as he remains in us is that we love in our deeds, and not merely talk about loving. St. Francis de Sales offers us some practical advice about how to do this each day. He encourages us to begin our day by being conscious of God's presence and love:

"My God, I know that you are here with me. You are loving me today. Help me to be conscious you are with me in everything I say and do today". Amen.

Then, as we begin each new activity of our day, he encourages us to be conscious again of God's presence and ask for the help of his grace so that we might do this activity in a way that is pleasing to God. When we make this short prayer at the beginning of each of our activities and trust in God's presence and love with us, we are better able to accept any difficulties we may meet in an activity and possibly see them as God's way of pruning us so that we can bear more fruit.

St. Francis De Sales' advice helps us to remember that we are branches on Jesus, the vine, as we go about the tasks of daily living. It also helps us to do our actions and speak our words in a way that is loving. Let us pray that his advice may help each of us to deepen our friendship with Jesus and to love one another more as Jesus has loved us.

St. Joseph the Worker

May 1st is dedicated in honor of Saint Joseph the Worker. In 1955, a huge part of the world was being influenced by Communism and by far Our Country is moving towards that and we know how it is going impact the strength, prosperity, and the future of our Nation.

So, among the efforts of Pope Pius XII to counter the evil effects of Communism's atheistic ideology was the institution of a new feast in honor of Saint Joseph the Worker. Pius XII placed it on May 1st, the same day that the Communists held their "May Day" celebration: an anti-religious, purely secular commemoration of labor. To counter the communist view, Pope Pius XII placed before the faithful the example of Saint Joseph the Worker, true model of all workers.



Saint Joseph the Worker is the patron saint of all workers who get up and go to work every day to support the family they love and cherish. Catholic tradition has always held a deep respect for the dignity of human labor as a participation in the creative work of God. Saint Paul says that we are "God's coworkers" (1 Corinthians 3:9). The book of Genesis (2:15) tells us of God's command to man to till the earth and let it become fruitful.

Saint Joseph is a model of work with respect and dignity. Pope Francis says, "work anoints us with dignity." Let us draw our inspiration from Saint Joseph and participate in the creative activity of our God. Reflect on your work as a participation in the creative activity of our God and be grateful for the opportunity to participate in this noble calling. Take a few moments to thank the many who work for you. We know that there are numerous people who work for us every day, most of whom we will never meet. Just be grateful!




