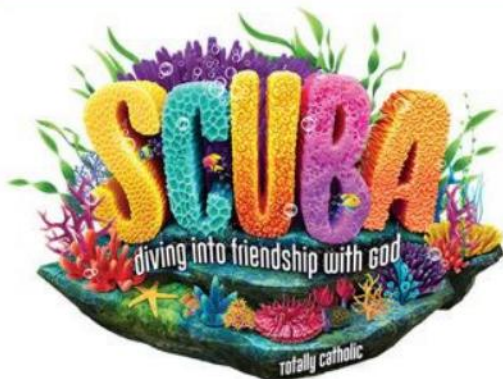


THANK YOU

Remember to Vote NO on Amendment 4 this fall. It is TOO Extreme. More information to come.



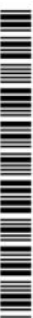

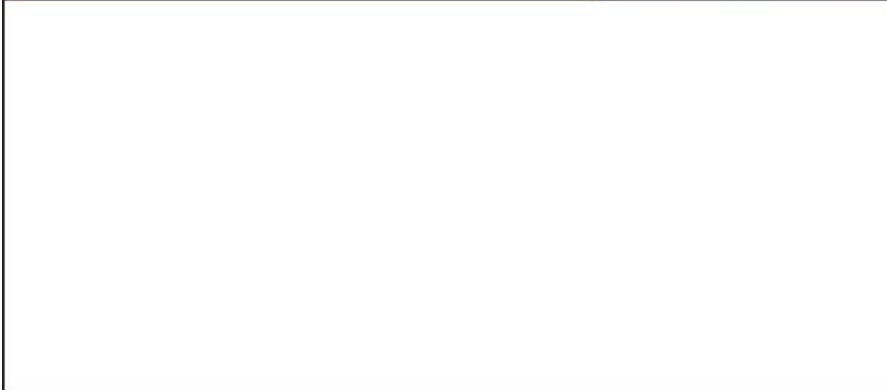
