## Fatima Statue Available Weeks

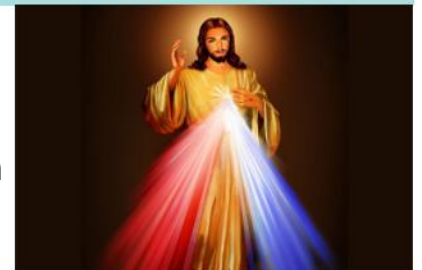
There are several weeks open to have our Fatima Statue at your home for prayer:

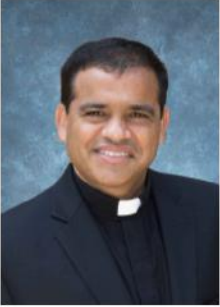

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



## **"Why are you terrified?" Do you not yet have faith?"**

We all go through different storms in our lives. At those times we are like the disciples in today's gospel asking the same questions to our Lord. "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing? We all have things in life that should concern, scare - and even - terrify us. Jesus is not asking us to never be fearful or even terrified; rather, Jesus asks us to trust him precisely in times of timidity, tempests and terror. It is only faith in His teaching that can save us from perishing. We should trust in Christ, and trust like Christ—who was able to sleep through the storm, confident that God was with Him.

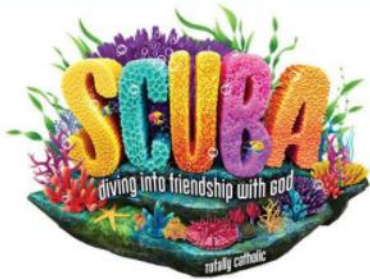

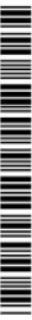

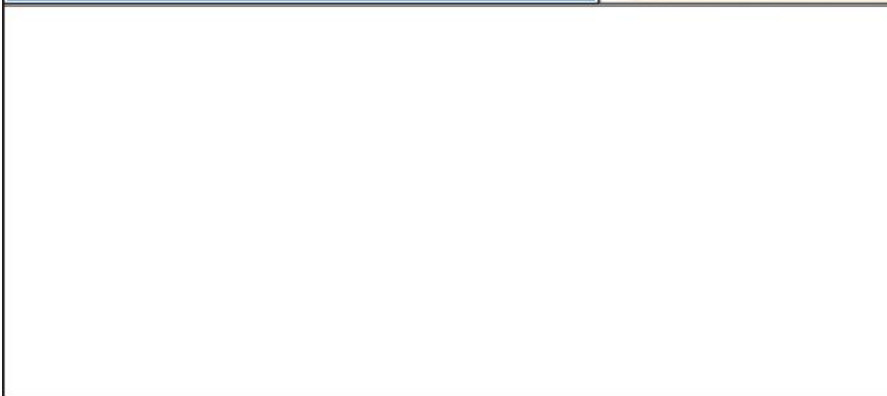
