

"Why are you terrified?" Do you not yet have faith?"

We all go through different storms in our lives. At those times we are like the disciples in today's gospel asking the same questions to our Lord. "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing? We all have things in life that should concern, scare - and even - terrify us. 
