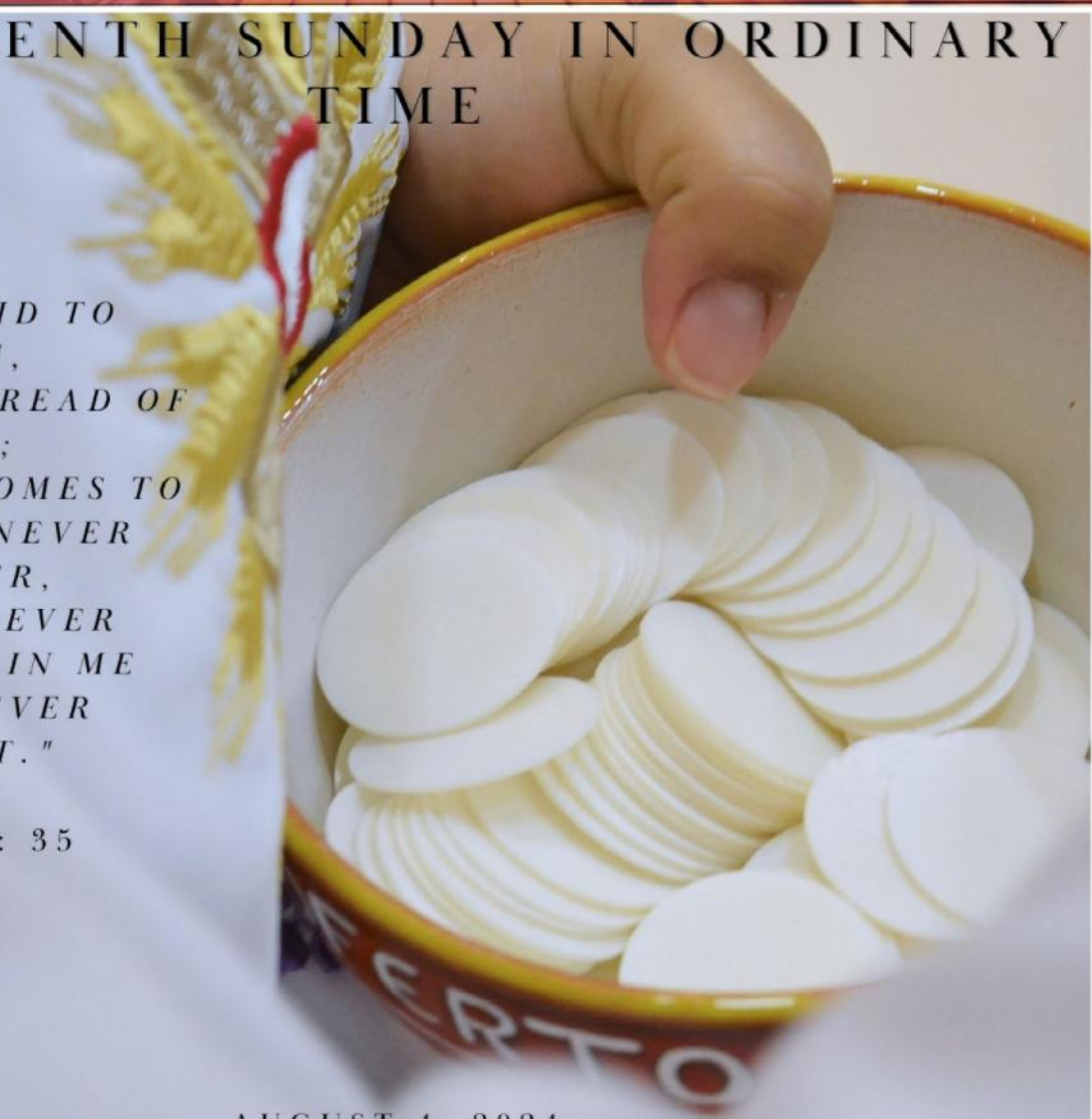

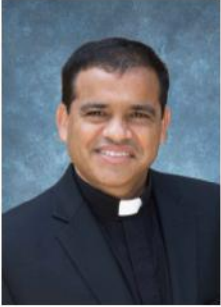

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

And we begin now the month of August, which reminds us of summer flowers and harvest time. I hope you will make the best of summer harvest and celebrate with colorful flowers, fruits, vegetables and more. It is a good time for us to slow down and reflect, find some quiet time to get through the rough days of the summer. We can make it a joyful time by taking a break from the routines and having fun with our family and friends.

The month of August also brings us some amazing memories, both joyful and sorrowful. August 6th is the feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord, celebrating the glory of the Lord being revealed on the mountain. 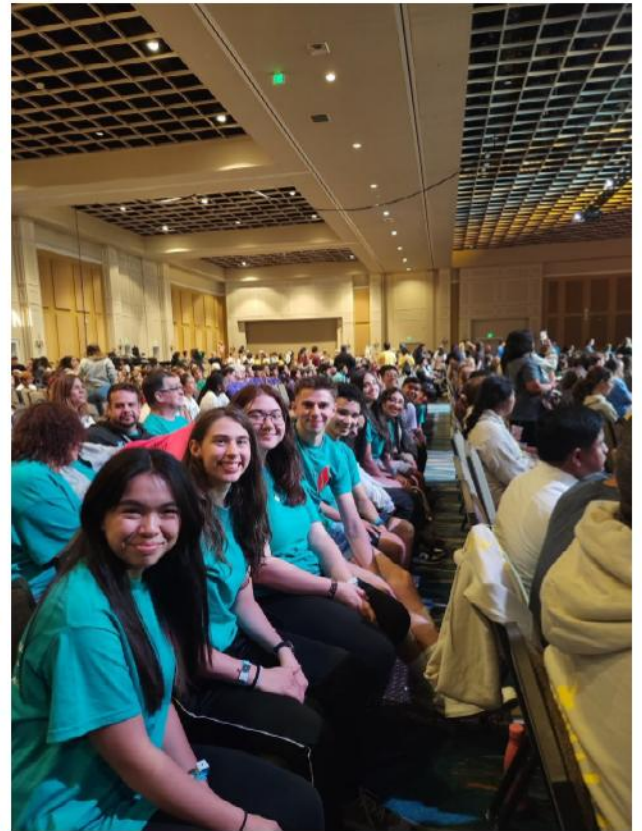
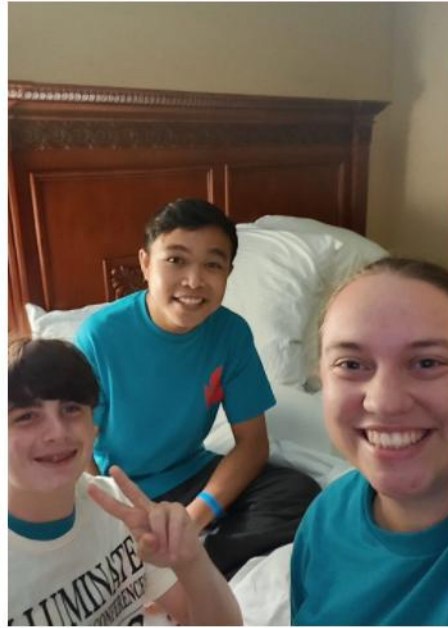

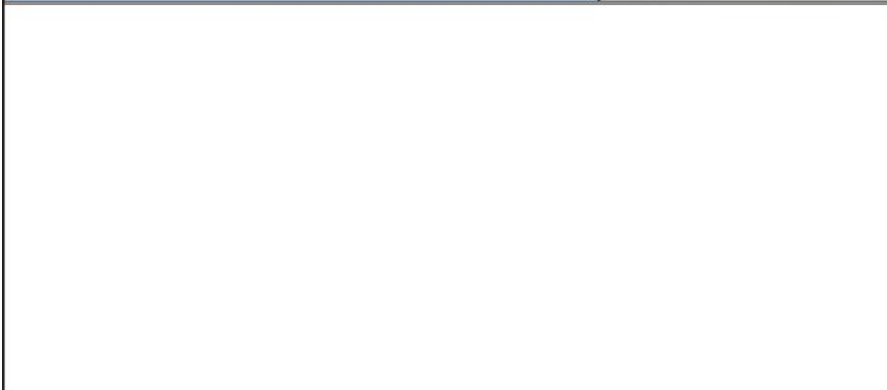
