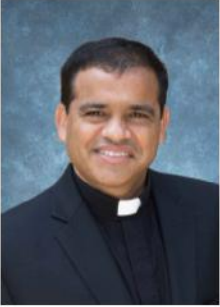

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The past week had been very challenging for all of us due to the storm "Debby". But we are grateful to God that nothing serious happened around us. We pray for all those who lost their lives and have been affected by this storm. As some of you might know that recently there was a major disaster in the District of Wayanad, State of Kerala, India, where 402 people lost their lives and still 170 people are missing due to flash flood and mud slides. We pray for all those who were affected by this terrible Natural Disaster.

As people of God, we are called to "Hope and Act with Creation" means to imagine and participate in God's life-giving, life-affirming work of bringing into existence a vastly different reality from what is in front of us. The environmental crises, violence, poverty, and social discord grip our world today beg for us to embody an alternative way of being with and in God's creation. This is our challenge, and with the Lord, anything is possible. We pray that each one of us will hear and take to heart the cry of "Mother Earth" and of the victims of natural disaster, and that all will undertake to personally care for the world in which we live.

Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

On August 15th, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a holy obligation for all the Roman Catholics. In reflecting on the solemn celebration, we might ask, what is the "Secret" that characterized the lives of Jesus and Mary? It is Service and Praise. Today as we contemplate her ascending in body and soul to the glory of heaven, we also see Mary, in the gospel, ascending "into the hill country" to help her cousin Elizabeth. It is there that Mary proclaims the joyful canticle of the Magnificat.

"Mary ascends, and the word of God reveals to us what characterizes us as she does so: "service to her neighbor and praise to God" which mirrors the life of her Son. "Jesus and Mary" travel the same road, two lives that ascend upwards glorifying God and serving the brethren". What is service? It is when we stoop to serve our brothers and sisters that we rise; it is love that elevates". At the same time, serving others is not easy, there is a cost to helping others. Like Mary, who travelled a long way to be with Elizabeth, we too find that being in service to others involves fatigue, patience and worries. But remember, it is ascending upwards, it is to gain heaven.

However, service also involves giving due praise to God, otherwise it becomes barren. Remember that after her long journey, Mary did not dwell on her weariness; rather "a song of jubilation springs from her heart, because those who love God know praise". At the sound of Mary's joyful greeting, the child leaps with joy into Elizabeth's womb". Praise is like a ladder; it leads hearts upwards. So, do we make service the 'springboard' of our life? Do we, like Mary, exult in God? And, after praising Him, do we spread His joy among the people we meet? So, we pray that "Mary our Mother, assumed into heaven may continue to help us to climb higher each day through prayer and service". Let us be close to each other in spirit and prayer as we continue our journey through life with all its joyful moments as well as not so joyful. Have a blessed week!
