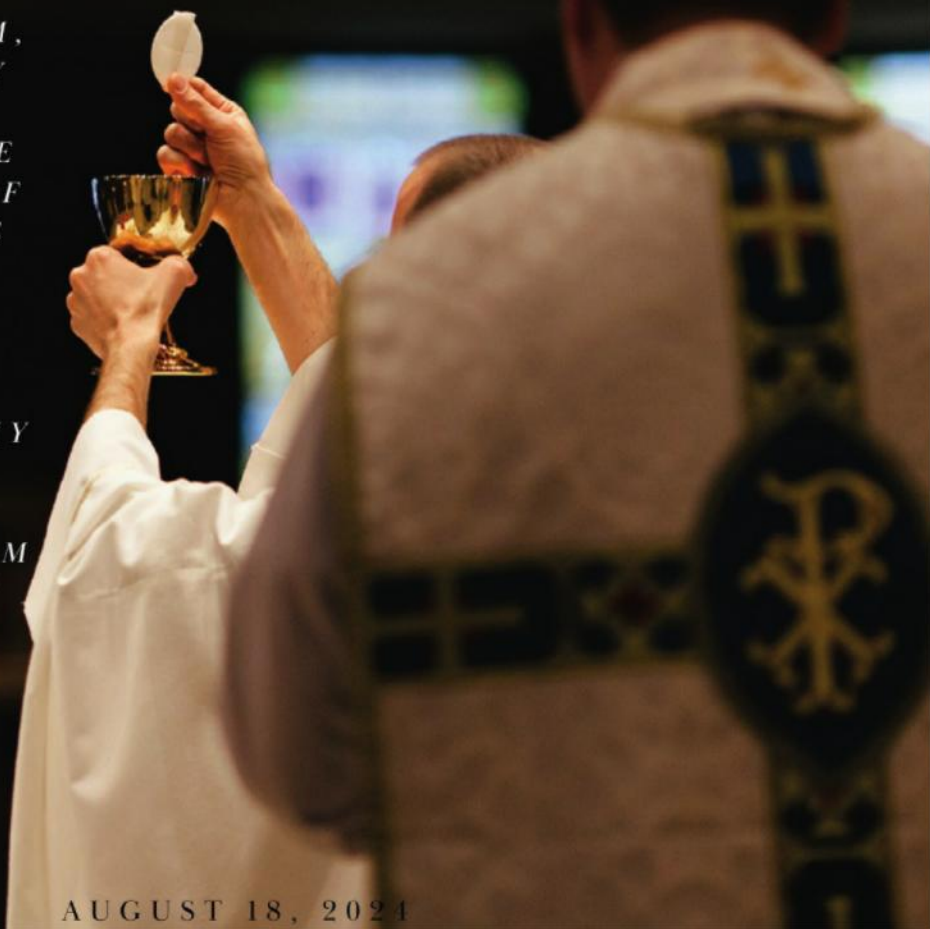

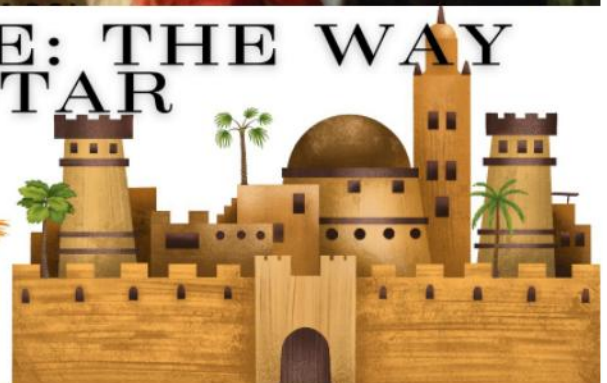

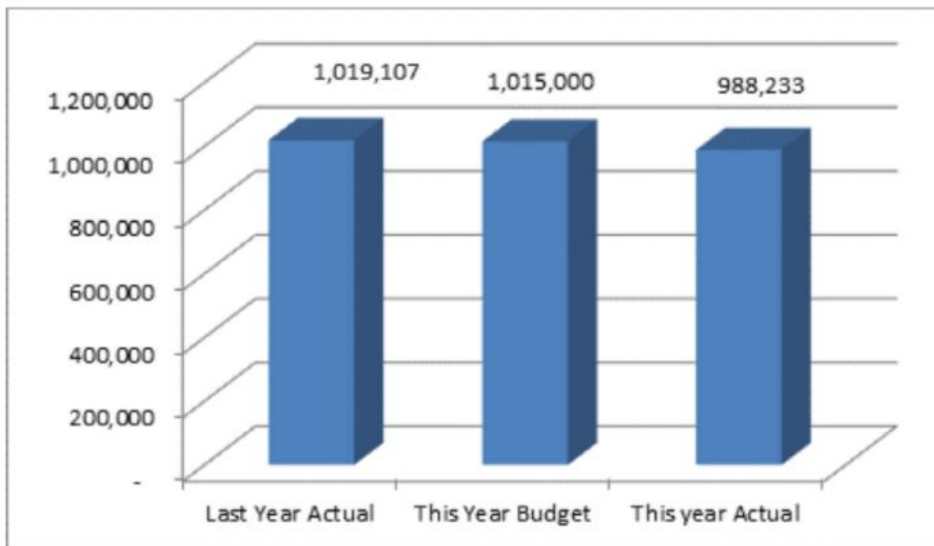
Financial Report

Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2024

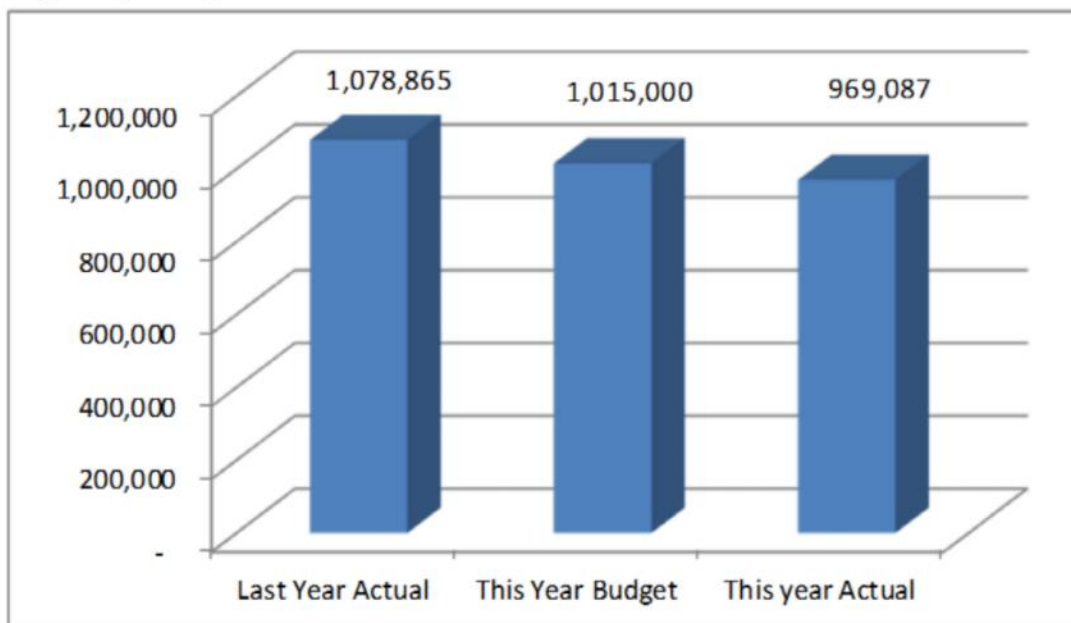

CHURCH INCOME AND EXPENSE

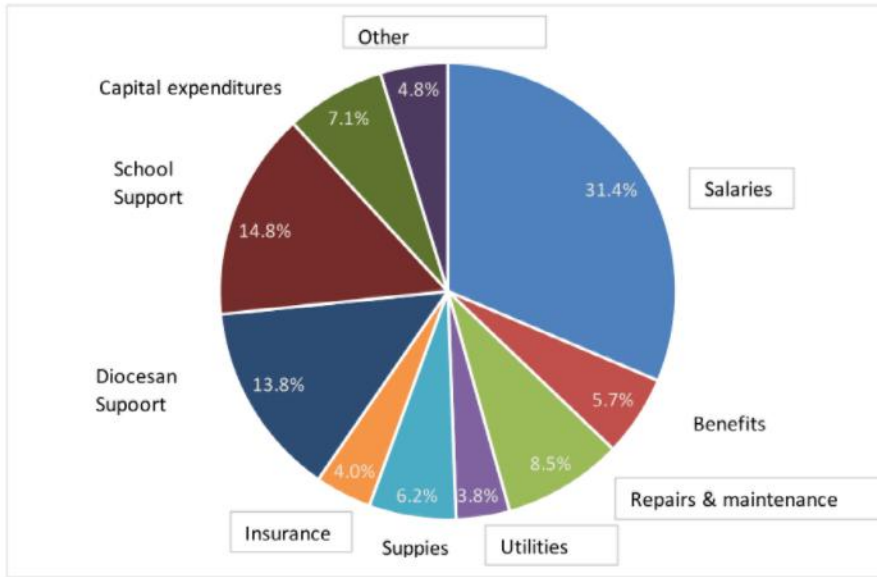
Income for the church was lower this fiscal year compared to both last year's actual and budget. Economic conditions in the country have had a negative impact on our income. However, we feel very blessed and greatly appreciate the generosity of our parishioners.



Expenses for our church were lower than both the actual and budget last year. Last year's expense included the major capital improvement costs for the renovation of the church lobby, both sacristies, our hospitality room, and three restrooms.



This is where the money was spent this year:



FAMILY LIFE CENTER

Thanks to all who participated in our Family Life Center Debt Reduction Campaign which exceeded our expectations. We received contributions in the amount of \$195,865. This allowed us to pay our monthly mortgage payment of \$5,771, the property insurance payment of \$24,000, and make additional principal payments for the year of \$103,000.

The balance of the mortgage loan as of June 30, 2024, is \$255,511.

IMPROVEMENTS THIS YEAR

- Completed re-roofing the rest of our school roof. We re-roofed 60% of the roof (3) years ago, and now the balance was completed in June.
- Replaced school library air conditioner
- Approximate total cost for both improvements listed above was \$76,500 which was shared by the church and school
