



THE ABORTION AMENDMENT

IT'S NOT WHAT IT SEEMS - AND IT'S WAY TOO EXTREME.

So... this amendment eliminates all limitations and regulations on abortion — even safety regulations

Not defined anywhere in the amendment...

that protect women

Wow...any "healthcare provider" - NOT just doctors - could determine viability or exceptions for "patient's health". It could even be a non-medical staff member at an abortion clinic....
BIG loophole makes limitation meaningless.

TITLE: Amendment to Limit Government
Interference with Abortion

SUMMARY: No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion before viability or when necessary to protect the patient's health, as determined by the patient's healthcare provider. This

amendment does not change the
Legislature's constitutional
authority to require notification to
a parent or guardian before a minor
has an abortion.

Catechetical Sunday




"Lord, when did we see you hungry" Matthew 25:37

Catechetical Sunday this year invites us to reflect our call to missionary discipleship. As St John Paul II reminded us: The universal call to holiness is closely linked to the universal call to mission. Every member of the faithful is called holiness and to mission. We are called to be eucharist by word and action to our brothers and sisters in Christ. Our times cry out for this kind of holiness, one inflamed by the ardent determination to bring as many of our brothers and sisters as possible to Christ.

What is Catechetical Sunday?

The Church established Catechetical Sunday, which is always celebrated on the third Sunday in September, to recognize and celebrate the gift that catechists give to their parish community by volunteering their time for the faith formation of children. We come together as a church community to acknowledge the dedication of those who serve as catechists in our parish family.

The day also reminds all Catholics to consider ways we are witnesses for Jesus Christ. All Catholics could rededicate themselves to the mission of passing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel as a community of faith.





Catechetical Sunday

Who are Catechists?

The word catechesis is from a Greek word meaning "to echo." All those who teach the Catholic faith and share the Church's teachings, by word and by the way they live their lives, are catechists. The catechist's goal is always to set hearts aflame for Christ.

We celebrate and pray for all who come forward for this ministry. They are willing to share their own faith and have the courage to listen to the faith stories of others, without judgment but with a sense of wonder and awe.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God. (CCC2226) Therefore, moms, dads, stepparents, grandparents, foster parents, godparents, and all who form the faith of children at home, in the domestic church, are the first and most important catechists of their children.

I take this opportunity to sincerely thank and appreciate all our parishioners, especially CCD and OCIA teachers who dedicate their time and energy in teaching and importing faith to our children. Thank you for your mission to nurture a living, conscious and active faith in others, and to witness to the faith by sharing your faith commitment through word, experience, prayer and liturgy. May God bless you abundantly.


October 5th @ 8:30AM






