





THE ABORTION AMENDMENT

IT'S NOT WHAT IT SEEMS - AND IT'S WAY TOO EXTREME.

TITLE: Amendment to Limit Government
Interference with Abortion

So... this amendment eliminates all limitations and regulations on abortion — even safety regulations that protect women

Not defined — anywhere in the amendment...

Wow...any "healthcare provider" - NOT just doctors - could determine viability or exceptions for "patient's health". It could even be a non-medical staff member at an abortion clinic.... BIG loophole makes limitation meaningless.

SUMMARY: No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion before viability or when necessary to protect the patient's health, as determined by the patient's healthcare provider. This

amendment does not change the
Legislature's constitutional
authority to require notification to
a parent or guardian before a minor
has an abortion.

MAKING MISSIONARY DISCIPLES




My Sisters and Brothers,

Come join us for our 1st Saturday Mass, Anointing of the Sick and our Annual Rosary Procession around the church grounds at 8:30AM.










