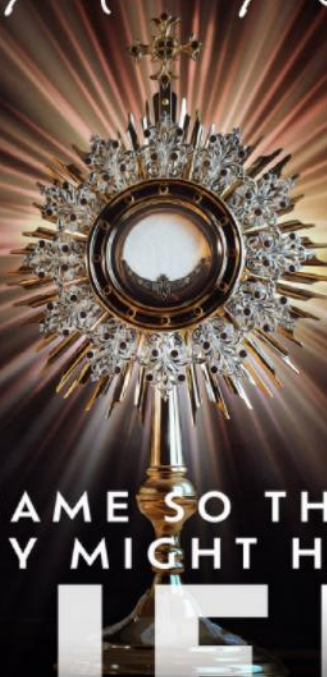

**TITLE:** Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion

Should say:  
"Amendment to legalize full-term abortion for any age without parental consent in Florida"

So... this amendment eliminates all limitations and regulations on abortion – even safety regulations that protect women

**SUMMARY:** No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion

Also not defined – even "mental stress" could qualify for the "patient's health" exception. **BIG LOOPHOLE**

Not defined anywhere in the amendment...

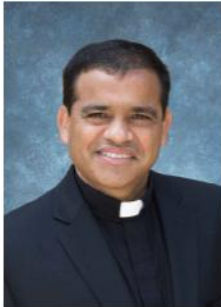

Wow...any "healthcare provider" – NOT just doctors – could determine viability or exceptions for "patient's health". It could even be a non-medical staff member at an abortion clinic... **BIG** loophole makes limitation meaningless.

healthcare provider. This amendment does not change the Legislature's constitutional authority to require notification to a parent or guardian before a minor has an abortion.

**ELIMINATES CURRENT PARENTAL CONSENT LAWS** – So, parents would be told their daughter is going to have an abortion, but unlike every other medical procedure – would not have to give their consent beforehand.

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



## RESPECT LIFE MONTH: 2024 "I Came So That They Might Have Life"

My Sisters and Brothers,

We all know that the Roman Catholic Church is always stands for Life. That, life is sacred, precious and a gift from God. But what we hear and see in the modern age is different from what we believe as Catholic Christians. A recent survey by EWTN News and RealClear Opinion Research shows that 50% of self-identified Catholics do not support life. What is more troubling is that 48% of Catholics who claim to

"accept all Church teachings and that is reflected in how I live my life" say that they would not support the Culture of Life. It is also important to note that 55% of Catholics who attend daily – Mass do support life. There are 52.2% of Catholics who believe in the Real Presence of The Holy Eucharist, that is "The transformed bread and wine are the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ and not symbols. Whereas 31.6% of Catholics do not believe in the real Presence of Jesus Christ in Holy Eucharist, that is, "The Bread and wine are Symbols of the Body and Blood of Jesus" and 16.3% of Catholics are not sure about it.

It is pivotal moment for all of us, because we celebrate and support life in all its forms. Every one of us are called by God to be the light of Christ which breaks through the darkness. We are called to be his disciples, continually transformed by our encounter with him and sharing in his mission. Jesus came that we might have life.

We live in a society that rejects those who are weak, fragile, or vulnerable. Yet, it is precisely within these conditions that a person is most in need of our care and protection. Pope Francis reminds us that "every child who, rather than being born, is condemned unjustly to being aborted, bears the face of Jesus Christ, bears the face of the Lord, who even before he was born, and then just after birth, experienced the world's rejection."

The U.S. bishops have affirmed that, while it is important to address all the ways in which human life is threatened, "abortion remains our pre-eminent priority as it directly attacks our most vulnerable brothers and sisters, destroying more than a million lives each year in our country alone."

As Pope St. John Paul II wrote, "we are facing an enormous and dramatic clash between good and evil, death and life, the 'culture of death' and the 'culture of life'. ...we are all involved, and we all share in it, with the inescapable responsibility of choosing to be unconditionally pro-life."

Dear friends, I pray that we may continue to value, celebrate and support life. Please plan to join us on Atlantic Blvd from 2:00 Pm to 3:30 Pm to peacefully and prayerfully stand up for life.

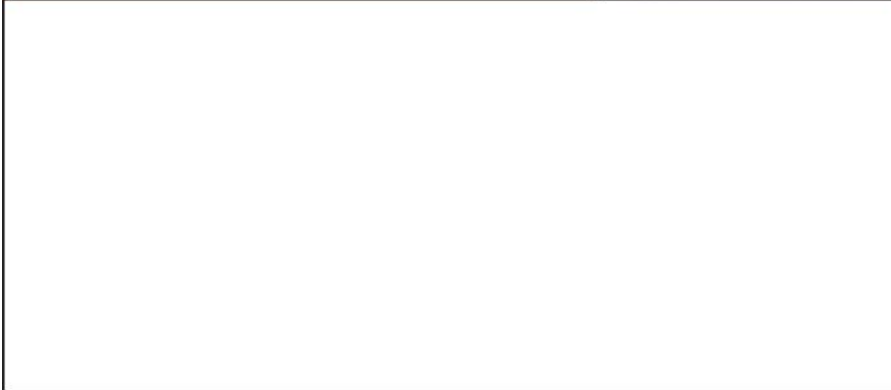
