

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



World Mission Sunday You shall be my witnesses Acts: 1-8

What is World Mission Sunday?

We celebrate World Mission Sunday each year as a day set aside for Catholics across the United States and around the world to recommit our missionary hearts in support of our evangelizing mission.

World Mission Sunday is one day with a year-long mission. As a key source of financial assistance for priests and religious and lay leaders in the Missions, World Mission Sunday provides the funds that builds churches and supports the proclamation of the Gospel in some 120 countries around the globe. Support the missionary work of the Church today in the most generous way you are able."

The Pontifical Mission Societies are active in 120 countries around the globe, gathering support for the efforts of nearly 1,100 mission dioceses in Asia, Africa, the Pacific Islands, remote regions of Latin America, and parts of Europe.

Our evangelical mission is to spread the gospel and local churches, including building houses of worship, seminaries, convents, schools, communications, and transportation as well as life sustaining infrastructure/programs.

As described by Saint Pope John Paul II, World Mission Sunday is "an important day in the life of the Church because it teaches how to give: as an offering made to God, in the Eucharistic celebration and for all the missions of the world." (Redemptoris Missio 81).

Laity Sunday

Laity Sunday reminds us of our call to grow in Synodality – in Communion with one another, by increased Participation in the parish Associations and Cells and reaching out to others in Mission.

Laity Sunday celebrates the ministry of all Christians to love God and neighbor. As we grow in grace to become disciples in community, we gather with others and connect them to God's love in Jesus Christ. We continue to lift the vocation of all to follow the way of Jesus and lead others to Him – particularly as we rediscover practices of togetherness that reveal "God's presence for the life of the world".

It is largely the laity who, living in the world, fearlessly proclaim the Good News through their words and deeds. The laity must be influencers, bringing the love of God to bear on their workplaces and centers of learning, becoming catalysts of change in situations of injustice and hatred, and making the world truly a better place!

On Laity Sunday, the Church wishes to acknowledge all the Laity in the parish for their active role in and outside the Church. The Church exists because of the laity. The number of active laity and the quality of their dedication depends on Christian families. This is also the day to remind the laity - each one of the baptized members of the 'body of Christ' to be an active, contributing member, called to fulfill the Mission of Jesus.

THE ABORTION AMENDMENT IT'S NOT WHAT IT SEEMS – AND IT'S WAY TOO EXTREME.

TITLE: Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion

Should say:
"Amendment to legalize full-term abortion for any age without parental consent in Florida"

So... this amendment eliminates all limitations and regulations on abortion – even safety regulations that protect women

SUMMARY: No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion before viability or when necessary to protect the patient's health, as determined by the patient's

Also not defined – even "mental stress" could qualify for the "patient's health" exception. **BIG LOOPHOLE**

Not defined anywhere in the amendment...

healthcare provider. This amendment does not change the Legislature's constitutional authority to require notification to a parent or guardian before a minor has an abortion.

ELIMINATES CURRENT PARENTAL CONSENT LAWS – So, parents would be told their daughter is going to have an abortion, but unlike every other medical procedure – would not have to give their consent beforehand.

Wow...any "healthcare provider" – NOT just doctors – could determine viability or exceptions for "patient's health". It could even be a non-medical staff member at an abortion clinic... **BIG** loophole makes limitation meaningless.


