FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



EMBRACING GOD'S MERCY

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The mercy of God is a gift to all who approach it, even though none of us truly deserves it. It springs from His boundless love. Because...

- 1. His mercy is a sign of God's salvation to humanity.
- 2. His mercy is greater than our sins.
- 3. His boundless mercy towards humanity is the path to holiness.
- 4. It is our misery that enables us to seek the mercy of God.

St. Francis de Sales made every effort to transmit God's mercy to people, especially through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. As a priest and a bishop, he ensured that confession was always accessible. As the provost of the diocese, he arranged for a confessional near the entrance of the Cathedral so that people could approach it with ease. He was always available for confession, sometimes remaining in the confessional from dawn until noon. He gave utmost importance to this sacrament because he firmly believed that our misery becomes the throne of God's mercy.

Pope Francis reminds us: "God's face is the face of a Merciful Father who is always patient. He understands us, waits for us, and never tired of forgiving us if we return to Him with a contrite heart. Great is God's mercy."

St. Francis de Sales encourages us to approach the throne of mercy regularly to experience His unconditional forgiveness, which in turn strengthens us to forgive others. By doing so, we become a reflection of the merciful Father in our lives through gentleness and compassion.



St. Francis believed in winning hearts and minds through love rather than harshness. When we receive God's mercy, we are also called to extend that mercy to others. This can be done in our daily lives by forgiving those who hurt us, assisting the sick, caring for the elderly at home or in the community, and offering a listening ear to those in distress. Even praying for the departed is an act of mercy, as St. Francis de Sales teaches: "To assist the souls in Purgatory is to perform the most excellent of the works of mercy."

Dear friends, true healing comes when we show compassion, forgive those who have wronged us, and thank God for allowing us to grow through these experiences. As we pray for God's mercy, let us continue to embrace the Risen Lord with renewed hearts and minds.

Dear Friends, please remember me in your prayers as I enter my 25th year of Priesthood on April 29th, 2025. I thank God for the gift of Priesthood and please pray for more vocations that many more young men and women may respond to His call.




