

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

#### THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

We are celebrating the feast of the Ascension of the Lord. The story of the Ascension of the Lord is the story of the Church being called, sent, and empowered to continue what Jesus began. It is the story of Jesus asking the disciples to become more fully involved. It is the story of the disciples being empowered to live and to share the good news of Jesus. The feast of Ascension calls us to wait and remain open to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit and be empowered to continue to fulfill the mission of Jesus.

Jesus sends them with his message to fulfill his mission. He said to them, "Go into the whole world and proclaim the good news to all creation." Men of weak faith, men who could not see beyond their disappointment, men who did not grasp all that Jesus said to them about his death and resurrection while he was among them, were sent to proclaim the good news of the resurrection! (Mark 16:15-20, Today's Gospel) Jesus trusted 1 these men with all their "disbelief and stubbornness" and sent them with his mission of bringing good news to the world.

What a surprise! Today, we, with all our limitations, inconsistencies, hesitations, lack of understanding and misunderstanding, are trusted with this good news and sent to bring this good news of Jesus to the world, just as the disciples were. The Lord has surprised us just as he did his disciples! So, let us not wait or hesitate to share and announce the good news of God's love till we have fully matured in faith! Now is the moment to witness Christ and proclaim his Gospel! Let us be his witness today!

Before the Lord Jesus ascended into heaven, His last words were, "You will receive power when the holy Spirit comes upon you and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8, First Reading). Witnessing to Jesus was a command, not a choice. The disciples followed the master's command and boldly testified, "we were eyewitnesses from the beginning" (Luke 1:2).

Our lives are the only Bible some people will ever read! We need Christian to make Christians. Full of life and energy or tired and weary, let us choose to give faithful witness to who we are and whose we are.... Be disciples of Jesus wherever we may be and whatever we may be doing. Have a Blessed week!


