



# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Is it a mortal sin to miss Mass on a Sunday or other holy day of obligation?

In the Catholic Church, missing Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation without a serious reason is considered a mortal sin. This obligation stems from the Third Commandment, "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy," which is interpreted as

dedicating time to worship God, primarily through the Holy Mass.

## Here's a more detailed explanation:

#### Mortal Sin:

A mortal sin is a serious offense against God that breaks the relationship with God. It requires three conditions:

Remember that there are three components to a mortal sin: grave matter (which would apply here), full knowledge, and full consent of the will (see CCC 1854-64).

The Church's discipline is the same whether with Sunday Mass (CCC 2180–2183) or another holy day of obligation (see The Code on Canon Law [CIC], canons 1245; 1247–1248). That is, there can be mitigating circumstances or ones that fully excuse if a person misses Sunday Mass.

- 1. The act must be a grave matter.
- 2. The person must have full knowledge that it is a sin.
- 3. The person must freely and deliberately choose to commit the sin.

## The Church provides in general:

The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice. For this reason, the faithful are obliged to participate in the Eucharist on days of obligation, unless excused for a serious reason (for example, illness, the care of infants, medical emergencies in the family and serious health reasons) or dispensed by their own pastor.119 Those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin (CCC 2181).

God knows definitively whether a person who has missed Mass on a Sunday or holy day of obligation has done so with grave culpability. In addition, a person should typically be able to evaluate his actions in such a case. If he has any questions, a good priest can provide discerning counsel.

Finally, if one anticipates he might have trouble fulfilling his Sunday or other holy day of obligation to participate in Mass, he may seek a dispensation in advance from his parish pastor (see CCC 2181; CIC, canon 1245)

# **AROUND OUR PARISH**



#### More Details:

- **Sunday Obligation:** The Catechism emphasizes the importance of the Sunday Eucharist as the foundation of Christian life and requires faithful Catholics to participate in Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation.
- **Grave Matter:** Deliberately missing Mass without a valid reason is considered a grave matter, meaning it's a serious offense against God.
- Mortal Sin: For a sin to be mortal, it must involve grave matter, knowledge that it's a sin, and full consent of the will. If all three conditions are met when missing Mass, it can be a mortal sin.
- **Excuses:** Certain circumstances can excuse a person from the obligation to attend Mass, including:
- Illness: Being sick or caring for the sick is a valid reason to miss Mass.
- Emergencies: Unexpected events or emergencies can also excuse one from attending Mass.
- **Inability to attend:** If finding a Mass to attend would cause significant burden or hardship, or if there is no Mass available, one is excused.
- **Dispensation:** A bishop or pastor can also grant a dispensation, releasing a person from the obligation to attend Mass.
- Other Considerations: Even when excused from the obligation, it is recommended to participate in prayer, either individually, as a family, or in a group, if possible.

There are exceptions for missing Mass, such as illness, medical emergency in the family, caring for the sick, a nursing mother or other circumstances beyond one's control.

## The Eucharist:

The Eucharistic celebration Mass is the central act of Catholic worship, where the Eucharist (Holy Communion) is celebrated. Missing Mass is seen as neglecting this central act and rejecting the grace offered through it.

### **Deliberate Action:**

It's important to note that it is the deliberate and unexcused failure to attend Mass that constitutes a mortal sin. (Those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin (CCC 2181). A person who misses Mass due to circumstances beyond his or her control, or who is genuinely unable to attend, is not committing a mortal sin.

# Prayerful and Sacred Silence before Mass

This guide can be an aid in hearing Jesus' voice and speaking with him as you prepare for Holy Mass. I invite you to pray one of the prayers below so that you can more fully participate in the sacred mysteries.

## Anima Christi

Soul of Christ, sanctify me. Body of Christ, save me. Blood of Christ, inebriate me. Water from the side of Christ, wash me. Passion of Christ, strengthen me. O Good Jesus, hear me. Within your wounds hide me. Permit me not to be separated from you. From the wicked foe, defend me. At the hour of my death, call me and bid me come to you, that with your saints I may praise you for ever and ever. Amen.

## Lectio Divina

- Reading (lectio) Choose one of the Sunday readings, and read it several times, leaving room for the Holy Spirit to call your attention to a word, phrase, or line that God wants you to hear.
- Meditation (meditatio) Think about the word or words that the Holy Spirit has called to your attention, holding them in your mind and considering them from different angles.
- **3. Prayer** (*oratio*) Respond to the sacred words in prayer, either silently or in writing.
- Contemplation (contemplatio) Rest in God's presence, quieting yourself and listening for God's response to your prayer.



Daily Readings- USCCB

Our prayers are our way of communicating with God in a personal and familiar way. When we pray, we reinforce our relationship with Jesus Christ, and we strengthen our bond as a son or daughter of God.

## P.A.C.T.

#### P: Petition

"First of all, then, I ask that supplications, prayers, petitions, and thanksgivings be offered for everyone"
-1 Tim 2:1

Pray for those who are sick, alone, in your family, in need, who you miss, who you are estranged from, who are deceased. Then pray for your own needs and desires on your heart.

### A: Adoration

"I saw coming with the clouds of heaven one like a son of man. When he reached the Ancient of Days and was presented before him, he received dominion, splendor, and kingship" -Dan 7:13-14

With the angels and saints in heaven, worship God the Father seated on the throne. Adore His Son, our Savior, with deep love and devotion. Praise the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life.

#### C: Contrition
