



Planning for the Future of the Diocese -

Bishop Pohlmeier Wants Your Feedback!

The Diocese of St. Augustine is considering a capital campaign for the benefit of both the diocese and each parish. In a recent letter to the priests of the diocese, Bishop Erik Pohlmeier shared his vision for this initiative:

"Our mission is inspired by Christ's call to 'Go and make disciples of all nations' (Mt 28:19). As we look ahead, it is clear that in order to continue living out that mission—especially amid the exciting growth in Northeast Florida-we must plan wisely for the future.

We've been presented with a unique opportunity: the potential acquisition of the St. Augustine property of the Sisters of St. Joseph. In response, diocesan leadership has developed a thoughtful plan for the use of the facilities on the property, to strengthen our parishes, and expand the resources that support our efforts to share the Gospel more effectively.

This opportunity could become a landmark moment for our diocese and shape our ministries

for generations to come. "This isn't about buildings or budgets-it's about helping people encounter the hope, peace, and joy that only Christ can bring," shared Bishop Pohlmeier.

To help guide our decision-making, Bishop Pohlmeier would like to hear from you.

We are partnering with the Steier Group, a trusted Catholic consulting firm, to conduct a planning study. The study will gather feedback from parishioners across the diocese to assess support for the proposed campaign. Your input is invaluable in helping us discern how best to move forward. Should we decide to proceed, the study will also help identify potential campaign leaders and establish a realistic campaign goal.


