




FELLOWSHIP AND PRAYER



FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS!



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Today, the Mother Church celebrates the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. It commemorates the finding of the True Cross in 325 by St. Helena, the mother of the Roman emperor Constantine I during a pilgrimage she made to Jerusalem. The Church of the Holy Sepulcher was then built at the site of the discovery, by order of Helena and Constantine. The church was dedicated nine years later, with a portion of the cross placed inside it. In 614, that portion of the cross was carried away from the church by the Persians, and remained missing until the Byzantine Emperor Heraclius recaptured it in 628. The cross was returned to the church the following year after initially having been taken to Constantinople by Heraclius. The date used for the feast marks the dedication of the Church of the Holy Sepulcher in 335. This was a two-day festival: although the actual consecration of the church was on September 13, the cross itself was brought outside the church on September 14 so that the clergy and faithful could pray before the True Cross, and all could come forward to venerate it.

Today's feast reminds us that the Cross is not a sign of defeat, but of victory. What once symbolized shame, suffering and death became, through Christ's obedience, the very instrument of salvation. As St. Paul teaches, "we proclaim Christ crucified... the power of God and the wisdom of God" (1 Cor 1:23–24).

The Cross reveals the depth of God's love: the Son of God humbled Himself to embrace death so that we might share in eternal life. To "exalt" the Cross is to lift high this mystery and to proclaim it as the tree of life that reconciles God and humanity.



For us as disciples, the Cross is both consolation and challenge. It consoles us, for Christ has transformed suffering into hope; it challenges us, because we are called daily to "take up our cross and follow Him" (Lk 9:23). Today, let us gaze upon the Cross not with fear, but with faith, making the sign of the Cross with devotion, and finding in it the pledge of God's victory over sin and death.

AROUND OUR PARISH

The exultation of the Cross challenges us to surrender mere human instinct to live on the higher plane of divine life. The exultation of the Cross challenges us to critically examine popular culture and to promote the culture of divine love. The exultation of the Cross challenges us to find greatness in littleness; to fight fire with peace; to confront violence with gentleness.

What is your Cross? A broken relationship; chronic illness; A terminal diagnosis for you or a friend; A job loss; An addiction; fallen away from the faith; fear of uncertainty; Not being accepted into a school, program or job? We don't need to go looking for crosses. They come to us, sometimes all too often. Imitate Jesus, honestly accept your cross, learn from it, and carry it, even with help. The cross is Jesus' victory over sin and death. Walk the Way of the Cross with Jesus in that difficult moment and find Jesus in your midst. May God be Praised!






