



FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Catholic Teachings on Socialism, Communism, and Capitalism

The Catholic Church's social teaching, rooted in the Sacred Scripture and Tradition, upholds the dignity of every human person and the right to private property while emphasizing our duty to seek the common good.

Socialism and Communism have been repeatedly condemned by the Church because they deny the natural right to private ownership and place the state above the human person, freedom and family. Pius XI in Divini Redemptoris (1937) called communism "a system full of errors and sophisms" that subverts the social order and destroys religion, marriage, and the family. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (2425) affirms: "The Church has rejected the totalitarian and atheistic ideologies associated in modern times with 'communism' or 'socialism.'"

Pope Pius IX and Pope Leo XIII warned that communism destroys social order and religion itself (Rerum Novarum, 15). By rejecting God and the moral law, these systems undermine human freedom and personal responsibility.

Capitalism, while recognizing private property and free enterprise, is not without moral limits. The Church affirms that economic freedom must be guided by justice and charity. When profit becomes the highest good, capitalism can lead to exploitation and materialism. As Pope St. John Paul II taught (Centesimus Annus, 42), a just economy must serve the people, not the other way around.

The Catholic vision is not aligned with any ideology but seeks a "human economy" rooted in solidarity, subsidiarity, and the preferential option for the poor. Christians are called to transform economic and social life by living the Gospel—protecting human dignity, promoting the common good, and ensuring that wealth serves the common good, not greed. In every age, Catholics are called to build a just society where work, wealth, and power serve love of God and neighbor, so that all may live in freedom and dignity before God.

Dear Friends, the Church calls us to see every economic system through the eyes of Christ. Socialism and communism promise equality, but they forget that true justice flows not from the State, but from the human heart renewed by God's grace. When we remove God from society, when property and family are placed under government control, we lose sight of the sacred dignity of the person made in His image.

But the Church also warns us: unrestrained capitalism can be just as dangerous. When profit becomes our master, when workers are treated as tools and the poor as burdens, we fall into another kind of slavery — the slavery of greed.

The Gospel calls us to a better way: a just society rooted in charity, truth, and the common good. In Christ, we find not an ideology, but a person — the One who teaches us to love, to serve, and to build an economy that honors both God and man. Amen.
