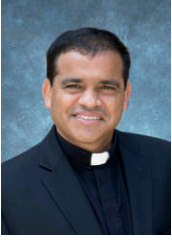


## NOW HIRING: FULL TIME MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

## Dedication of St. John Lateran Basilica

The Dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran is celebrated on November 9th and honors the cathedral church of Rome, the official seat of the Bishop of Rome, the Pope. Built in the fourth century by Emperor Constantine, it is the oldest and highest ranking of the four major basilicas of Rome. Dedicated first to Christ the Savior and later to St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist, it is considered the "Mother and head of all the churches in the city and the world." Though the building itself has faced fires, earthquakes, and reconstructions, its dedication reminds the faithful that the Church is not only a physical structure but the living Body of Christ. This feast celebrates the unity of all Christians with the Pope and with one another through the Church universal.



### Practical Lessons:

**Value the Church as Home:** Just as the Lateran Basilica stands as a mother church, we are reminded to treat our own parish church as a sacred home—a place to pray, serve, and gather as a family of faith.

**Remember We Are the Living Church:** The dedication points to the deeper truth that each of us is a temple of the Holy Spirit. As St. Paul teaches, "You are God's building... Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?" — 1 Corinthians (3:9, 16). Therefore, we are called to keep our "inner church" pure through prayer, virtue, and the sacraments.

**Stay United in Faith:** The Lateran Basilica symbolizes unity with the Pope and the worldwide Church. Today, this lesson calls us to pray for our Holy Father and strive to remain faithful to the teachings of the Church in charity and obedience.

**Prayer:** God our Father, You have made the Church Your dwelling place on earth and united us as living stones in the temple of Your Spirit. Through the intercession of St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist, may we remain strong in faith, devoted in worship, and steadfast in unity with the Church throughout the world. Amen.

## STEWARDSHIP SUNDAY

**Dear Friends,** as we celebrate Stewardship Sunday; the Church invites us to reflect on our sacred responsibility as stewards of God's gifts. Everything we possess—our time, our talents, and our treasures—comes from the generous hand of God. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that, "God entrusted the earth and its resources to the common stewardship of mankind" (CCC 2402). This means we are not owners, but caretakers, called to use God's gifts wisely for His glory and the good of others.



## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

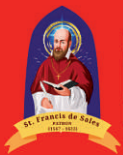
From the earliest days of the Church, believers shared their material blessings to support the work of the apostles and care for the poor (Acts 4:32-35). Jesus Himself praised the widow who gave her two small coins because she gave from her heart, not from her surplus (Mark 12:41-44). True Christian giving flows from gratitude—recognizing that all we have is a gift from God and returning a portion of it in love.

Supporting the Church financially is not merely a duty; it is an act of worship. If you have financial stress in your life, I encourage you to look at your giving. Is God first in your spending plan? Are you giving Him the amount that reflects how grateful you are for all the blessings and benefits He gives to you? Think about it, if we all gave what God asks us to give, how much more money would there be to sustain the parish's ministries, the celebration of the sacraments, catechesis, charitable works, and outreach to those in need? The Church depends on the faithful to continue her mission in the world—feeding the hungry, teaching the faith, and bringing Christ's presence to every corner of society.



St. Paul reminds us, “God loves a cheerful giver” (2 Corinthians 9:7). Giving should never be done out of guilt or pressure, but from love and gratitude. It is a sign of our trust in God’s providence—that He will provide for us when we are generous with Him. Let us, therefore, put God first in our finances. Give in return for His blessings. Gain that peace you seek and change the world. Let us renew our commitment to stewardship—not only with our money, but with our time in prayer, and our talents in service. When we give with open hearts, we build up the Body of Christ and make our parish a living witness of God’s generosity.

**Prayer:** Lord, teach us to be faithful stewards of all You have entrusted to us. Help us to give joyfully and generously, that Your Church may continue to shine as a beacon of Your love in the world. Amen.

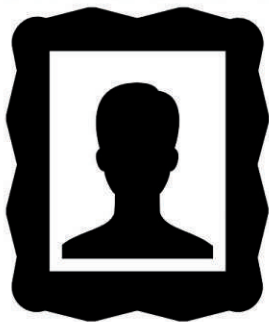

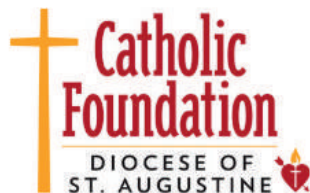
