




NEED FOR EUCHARISTIC ADORERS

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



"Repent, for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand..."

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

As we continue our Advent journey, we are given a wonderful passage where St. John the Baptist appears from the wilderness bringing the message of repentance. The word 'repentance' comes from the Greek word (meta = beyond, noia= mind), change of mind or one's way of thinking and perceiving. Repentance, therefore, involves changing the direction in which we are looking for happiness, turning to God, and altering how we think and act. Therefore, St. John the Baptist's message focusses on confession and repentance, urging us to confront our self-deceptive behavior. One of the signs that Jesus associates with the Kingdom of heaven being at hand is the driving out demons.



The season of Advent provides each of us with a great opportunity to drive out from our own minds and hearts any number of demons with which we might be plagued. These demons – while they are not necessarily limited to this list – could include:

"Anxieties, Grudges, Bitterness, Resentment, Old Hurts, Unresolved conflicts, Unbridled anger, Perfectionism, Scrupulosity, Negativity, Ingratitude, and Presumption".

The Kingdom of heaven is at hand, right now, right here and not in some abstract realm. Why not make more room in our life for the Word-Made-Flesh by driving out our demons through some heavy-duty spiritual house-cleaning between now and Christmas? It's a season to name and confess habits and sins that divide our hearts and block us spiritually and emotionally from producing abundant life. Let us prepare for Christ's Birth, as God is willing to enter our lives and take our vulnerability to give us hope amid hopelessness.

On December 8th, we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary**, the solemn dogma defined by Blessed Pope Pius IX in 1854. As Our Lady Immaculately Conceived is the patroness of the United States of America, this is a Holy day of Obligation for us.

Through the centuries the Church has become ever more aware that Mary, "full of grace" through God, was redeemed from the moment of her conception. That is what the dogma of the Immaculate Conception confesses, as Blessed Pope Pius IX proclaimed on December 8, 1854: "The most Blessed Virgin Mary was, from the first moment of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege of almighty God and by virtue of the merits of Jesus Christ, Savior of the human race, preserved immune from all stain of original sin." —Catechism of the Catholic Church.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, we are reminded of the mystery of God's infinite love for the human beings and as we learn to love by being loved by our parents and others, Blessed Mother was being loved into existence by God and His love was poured into her heart by the Holy Spirit from the beginning of her life. When she was able to respond to that love as she grew in that love, she said, 'Yes' to God's invitation to be His Mother. As Our Blessed Mother brought forth Christ to the world, let us bring forth Christ by witnessing to His presence through the fruits of the Holy Spirit.

On December 12, the Church in the United States celebrates the **Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe**. Today's feast is associated with the apparition of Our Lady to a native American peasant named Juan Diego on December 9, 1531. She left a marvelous portrait of herself on the mantle of St. Juan Diego. This miraculous image has proved to be ageless and is kept in the shrine built in her honor, the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe. In 1910, Our Lady of Guadalupe was declared Patroness of Latin America, and in 1945 Pope Pius XII declared Her to be the Empress of all the Americas. May our Blessed Mother continue to pray for us!


