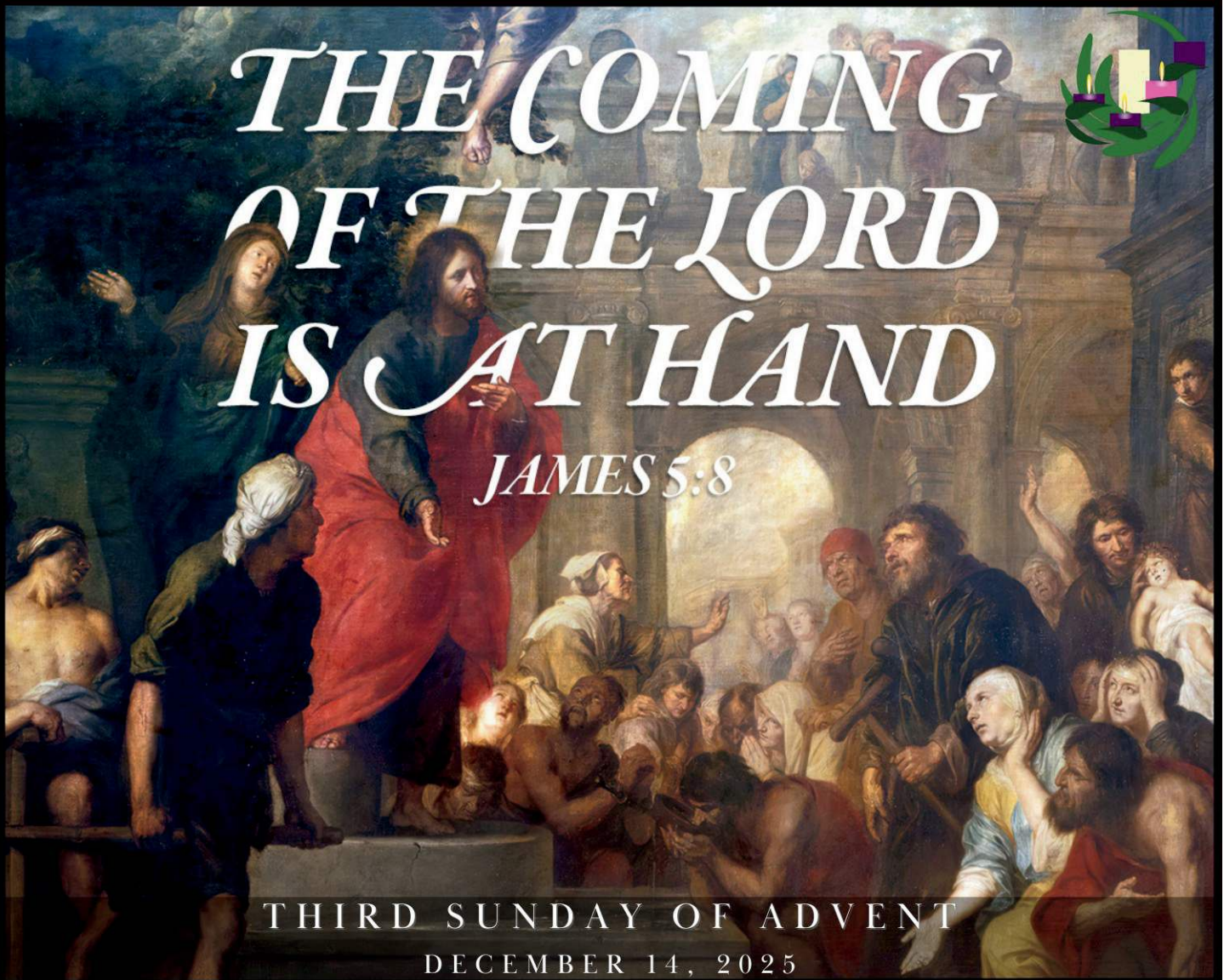

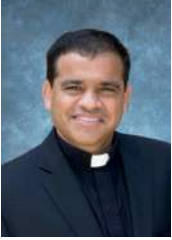

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



“There has been none greater than John the Baptist...”

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

St. Francis de Sales considered St. John the Baptist to be one of the greatest saints because his life and mission were not to draw the attention of people to himself but to point to another. In his Sermon for the Second Sunday of Advent, the Doctor of Love - in speaking of St. John the Baptist - states, “He did not want to draw disciples to himself, but only to his teacher, to whose school he now sends them so that they might be instructed personally by Him.” (The Sermons of St. Francis de Sales for Advent).

St. Jane de Chantal also comments on the example of humility we find in John the Baptist. “I would say that St. John never spoke in a more admirable manner than when he was asked who he was, for he always relied by a humble negative; and when he was obliged to answer positively, he said that he was only a voice, as much as to say that he was nothing; word in truth, well worthy of a prophet and of the great among them.” (“Exhortation XV”, St. Jane Frances Frèmyot De Chantal: Her Exhortations, Conferences and Instructions).

Dear Friends, in this holy season of Hope and Expectation, we can focus our attention on the model of St. John the Baptist who pointed the way to Christ. On our daily “earthly pilgrimage” to the fullness of the Kingdom, our lives and witness to Christ should not draw attention to ourselves but lead others to come to know and to encounter Christ. Like St. John, we are His messengers and ambassadors.

Today, in a spirit of humility, may we recognize that God uses each of us as His instruments to proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ to others.

Advent Reconciliation...

Our Advent Reconciliation is scheduled in December at 7:00 Pm in our Church. Everyone is invited to make use of this wonderful opportunity to reconcile and prepare our hearts and minds to worthily participate in the Birth of our Lord and Savior. We, the Catholics believe that the Sacrament of Reconciliation, also called Confession or Penance, is one of the greatest gifts Jesus left to His Church. After His Resurrection, Jesus breathed on the Apostles and said, “Receive the Holy Spirit. *Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained.*” (John 20:22–23). Through this gift, Christ Himself continues His healing ministry, restoring our relationship with God whenever we fall.

Sin wounds the heart, weakens our spiritual life, and disrupts our peace. But in Reconciliation, God does not simply erase guilt—He pours out grace that strengthens us against future temptation. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that this sacrament brings “spiritual resurrection,” returning us to the life of grace we received at Baptism.

Confession also deepens humility and honesty. By naming our sins aloud, we confront our weaknesses and open ourselves to God’s transforming mercy. This humility is not shame—it is truth lived in the presence of God, who never condemns but invites us to grow.

This Sacrament reconciles us not only with God but with the other and to oneself. Every sin affects the Body of Christ, and every confession brings healing to the whole community. That is why the priest, acting in the person of Christ and the Church, speaks the words of absolution: “I absolve you...”—a declaration of Divine Mercy.

Finally, Reconciliation restores joy. There is a deep peace in knowing we are forgiven, loved, and set free. Like the prodigal son, we return to the Father who runs to embrace us. In this sacrament, mercy is not an idea—it becomes a personal encounter with the forgiving heart of Jesus. Let us prepare our hearts and minds through this sacrament to celebrate and welcome again this *“Newborn King”* in our lives.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

A Guide to

Confession



BEFORE YOU GO

Examine your conscience, that is, reflect on what sins you have committed. To guide you, take an "Examination of Conscience" guide from the gathering area or just Google one. Preparing to receive the sacrament helps us open ourselves to God's grace and mercy.



INTRODUCTION

When you come before the priest whether sitting face to face or behind the screen, begin by making the Sign of the Cross, and continue by saying, "Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. It has been (how long) since my last confession. My sins are..."



CONFESSION

List the sins you've committed that came to mind during your examination of conscience or any that also come to mind during this time. Don't be too general ("I haven't been a good person"), but also don't be too detailed (you don't need to tell the whole story of how a sin came about). If you're not sure, ask the priest. Remember that this is not professional counseling, but the sacrament of Confession.



PENANCE

The priest will then give you something to do or pray as your penance. Penance is your response to God's mercy. You'll have to remember what this is and do it after the confession is over, so pay attention.



ACT OF CONTRITION

The priest will then ask you to pray out loud the "Act of Contrition": My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.



ABSOLUTION

After you pray the Act of Contrition, the priest will extend his hands and pray the Prayer of Absolution. Here, the priest acts in the person of Christ, so as to forgive your sins. Remember it's still God that is forgiving your sins, but he priest acts in the person of Christ at this moment.



CONCLUSION

The priest will then say some conclusion such as "Go in peace," and you can respond, "Thanks be to God." Don't forget to do your penance. If it is saying certain prayers, the best is to do it right away before you leave the church or before you forget.
