

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK



FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

We are in the last leg of our Advent journey preparing our hearts and minds to welcome once again our Savior, Jesus Christ. The readings taken for this this Sunday teaches us an important life lesson: God often enters our lives in unexpected ways. Like Ahaz in the first reading, we may hesitate. Like St. Joseph in the Gospel, we may struggle to understand. But God invites us to trust, not because we see clearly, but because He is faithful.

In our daily lives – family challenges, Uncertain futures, quiet worries – God is with us. He is with us in confusion, in obedience, and in courage. When we listen, trust, and act in faith, Christ is born anew in our lives, bringing hope, salvation, and peace to the world. So, Letting Jesus live in us as Emmanuel each day becomes our way of holiness and allows us to share his love with one another and with all we meet. May our Advent expectancy lead us to be vibrant messengers of the truth: “God is with us” saving his people! Now all is ready for our celebrating the coming of our God among us in Jesus. Our Advent longing and waiting takes on a heightened expectancy. The feast of Christmas is near.

“Behold, the virgin shall be with child and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel”, which means “God is with us”. Mt 1:23

Today, we celebrate Christmas, the birth of Jesus, the incarnation of God’s Word of love. We proclaim and affirm, once again, that we are a privileged people, a people blessed and graced by God’s unconditional love revealed in Jesus. As we celebrate Christmas, we contemplate the deepest and the most profound presence of God in our life. We contemplate the depth of God’s Love and compassion for us his children.

Christmas proclaims that we are born in an age of faith - maybe weak faith, shallow faith, irrational faith, superstitious faith - but Faith with all its limitations. I pray that you have the most profound experience of Emmanuel, “God-with-us” wherever you may be and whatever you may be doing. And may that experience be your hope and your strength. May all you do in this season bring you and your family lasting joy!

Be grateful for today and every day, for the miracle of life, for the amazing grace and blessing of your history, for the men and women who gave you spirit and tradition and for today, be especially grateful for the birth of Jesus and the hope that he proclaimed.

Thank you every one of you for your wonderful stewardship of gifts, talents, and treasures from God to our Holy Spirit Church and your unwavering support which continues to bear fruit in our faith lives and in the ministries of our Parish and School community. May your faithfulness and commitment help to build up a vibrant and faith filled Eucharistic Community which truly believes in the “Real Presence of Jesus”. “



UPDATING OUR WOODEN DOORS TO PUSH BARS


