

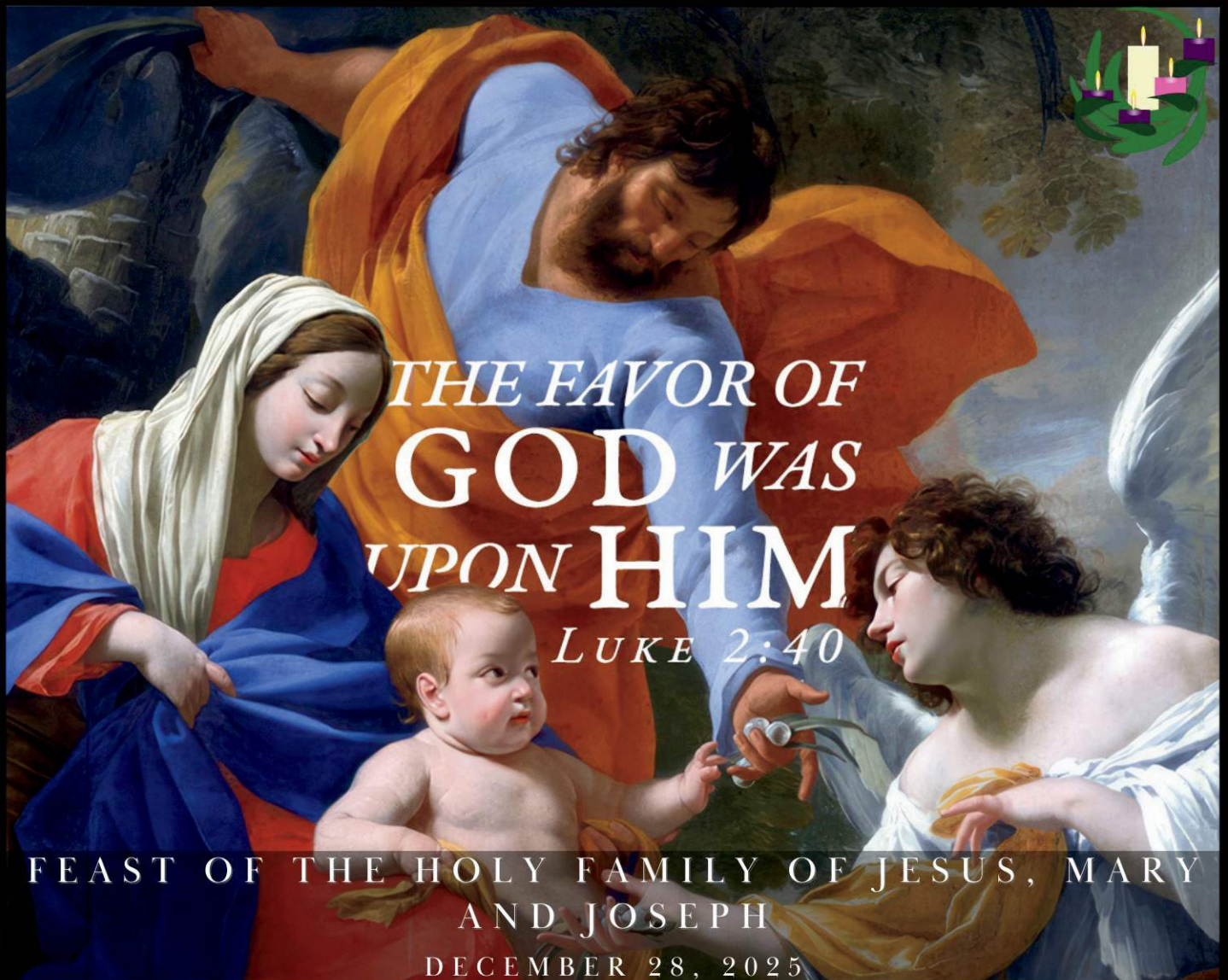

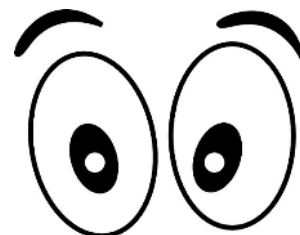

- Must be registered in Holy Spirit Catholic Church and has a desire to answer the call of Christ to serve others.

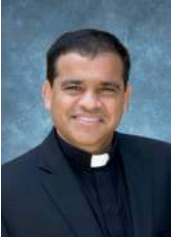

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY AND JOSEPH



My Sisters and Brothers,

The Feast of the Holy Family reminds our Catholic Christian families, married couples and young families that God chose a human family where His Son would grow in a loving and faithful atmosphere. Jesus, Mary, and Joseph show us that marriage and family life are sacred vocations, called to reflect God's love in the world.

From a doctrinal perspective, the Holy Family reveals the sanctity of marriage and the mission of the family as a domestic church. Mary and Joseph lived a marriage rooted in faith, fidelity, and openness to God's plan. Their union was centered on spiritual upbringing and on God's will. This teaches couples that the sacrament of Holy Matrimony is a covenant, sustained by grace, not merely a contract based on feelings.

The Holy Family also teaches the virtue of mutual self-giving. Joseph protected and provided; Mary nurtured and trusted; together they created a home where Jesus could grow "in wisdom, age, and grace." Their love was expressed through daily sacrifice, patience, and perseverance. For young families today, this reminds us that holiness is built in sleepless nights, financial struggles, misunderstandings, and daily responsibilities offered to God.

Another essential lesson is shared faith and prayer. The Holy Family prayed together, observed religious traditions, and trusted God even in uncertainty—during the flight into Egypt and their hidden life in Nazareth. For married couples, praying together strengthens unity. For children, seeing parents pray forms faith more powerfully than words alone.

Life Lesson:

Married couples are called to mirror Joseph's faithfulness to be a spiritual foster father and Mary's trusting openness to God's will. Spouses grow in holiness by forgiving quickly, communicating honestly, and placing Christ at the center of their decisions. Young families are encouraged to establish simple spiritual practices, family prayer, Scripture reading, faithful to the sabbath day, and act of charity.



FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

In a culture that challenges marriage and family life, the Holy Family assures us that God's grace and His loving protection are needed to sustain family life. When Christ is welcomed into the home, ordinary family life becomes extraordinary. By following the example of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, married couples and young families can build homes filled with faith, love, and enduring hope.

Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, Holy Family of Nazareth, bless our family and our home. Help us to love generously, forgive readily, pray faithfully, and trust completely in God's plan. Make our family a true domestic church. Amen.

Mary, the Mother of God, and the New Year 2026

As the Church begins the New Year, she places before us one of the most profound titles of the Blessed Virgin Mary: Mary, the Mother of God (Theotokos). This is not merely an honor given to Mary; it is a central doctrine of our faith, solemnly defined at the Council of Ephesus in 431. By calling Mary the Mother of God, the Church safeguards the truth that Jesus Christ is the second person of the Holy Trinity, true God and true man. Mary did not give birth to a nature, but to a Person—the eternal Son of God made flesh.

The Church celebrates this mystery on January 1, teaching us how to begin every year: with Christ, through Mary. As Mary freely said yes to God's plan, she teaches us to entrust the unknown future of 2026 into God's loving hands. Her motherhood did not end at Bethlehem; on the Cross, Jesus entrusted her to us all. She continues to intercede for the Church as a tender and powerful mother.



Saint Paul reminds us, "When the fullness of time had come, God sent His Son, born of a woman" (Galatians 4:4). Time itself was transformed through Mary's consent. Therefore, as we enter a new year, we consecrate our time, our families, our work, and our hopes to God through her maternal care. I pray that all your heart's desires will be fulfilled through the powerful intercession of Our Blessed Mother.

And May 2026 be a year where we walk with Mary—closer to Jesus, deeper in faith, stronger in hope, and richer in love. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us, now and throughout the new year. Amen


