



# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Sisters and Brothers,


A traveler once stopped at the edge of a desert and asked an old guide, "How long will it take to cross?" The guide replied, "Walk." "But how long?" the traveler insisted. "Walk," the guide repeated. Only when the traveler began the journey did the guide finally say, "About forty days."

Today, dear friends, we stand at the edge of a similar journey. With Ash Wednesday we have stepped into the desert of Lent— forty days set apart, not to escape life, but to rediscover its direction. These are days taken out of the rush of the year, taken out of habit and routine, so that God may act in us and through us. Ash Wednesday reminded us of two truths we often forget: *Life is fragile. Time is precious.* Yet it also spoke of a word of hope: *God is near, and now is the time of grace.* As we begin this Holy Season, aware of the suffering of our world—especially of people affected by war, violence, injustice and those who are going through pain, suffering and who are terminally ill—we ask God to turn our hearts back to him, so that we may become instruments of peace, compassion, healing and strength.

**Salesian Quote:** "True devotion consists in a constant, resolute, prompt, and active will to do whatever we know is pleasing to God." - Introduction to the Devout Life IV.13

On this first Sunday of Lent, we see Jesus being offered some incredible things of this world in the gospel. However, he doesn't have to think about them. He doesn't need to make a pro/con list or run a cost/benefit analysis. He simply hears what is offered and rejects it. He knows what he is about and to whom he belongs.

Today, as we move about a world filled with temptations for pleasure, power, and wealth, may we always seek to imitate Christ in the way we make our daily decisions, both the great ones and the small ones. Let us pray that we may grow in devotion, always resolute and prompt in doing good. And may we, like our Lord, constantly remember what we are about and to whom we belong. Have a Blessed Lent.



**Dear Friends in Christ,**

Over the last several months, many of you have participated in surveys and conversations about our shared future. I am deeply grateful for your openness and care. Your engagement reflects a sincere desire to be faithful stewards of the gifts entrusted to us, and I am thankful for the spirit that guided these conversations.

### **What We Learned Together**

Through this listening process, we explored several possible paths forward — addressing both immediate needs and longer-range goals. The feedback affirmed the importance of these priorities and the wisdom of moving forward with focus and care, recognizing that not everything could or should be addressed at once. The study results show good support from those who participated, but they also revealed something important: many of the faithful in our diocese did not take part. This tells us that more work is needed in communication and fostering relationships. It is crucial to our mission that we develop a shared sense of purpose and identity that will renew our communities throughout the Diocese of St. Augustine — the *First Coast of Catholicism* for our nation.

### **Our Path Forward**

After prayerful consideration and discernment, our immediate focus will be on two interrelated priorities: *First*, we will partner with the Sisters of St. Joseph as they transition to a smaller facility better suited to their current needs. The Sisters' witness of faith and service has shaped generations of Catholics in our diocese. Responding to their needs is a responsibility we embrace with gratitude, and they have committed to helping us address our goals. Together, we have the opportunity to preserve the unique Catholic heritage that is ours alone while revitalizing these facilities for broader endeavors that will serve the mission of the Church now and for generations to come. *Second*, we will deepen our work of communication and partnerships across the diocese. Building stronger relationships and clearer understanding is essential to everything we hope to accomplish together. Fostering mature discipleship and a shared identity unites us in mission.



# FROM THE BISHOP'S DESK

## Looking Ahead

Our longer-range goals remain clear: continued growth in various parts of the diocese through additional Catholic high schools and elementary schools, expanded church facilities to serve existing parishes and educational facilities, and enhanced support for priestly vocations, senior priest care, and lay ministry formation. Other ideas raised during the listening process remain part of our ongoing strategic discernment. No decisions have been made regarding those areas, but they will continue to be considered as we seek together to serve the people of God entrusted to our care.

## Moving Forward Together

We stand at a moment of incredible challenge and opportunity — called to honor our past while building faithfully toward our future. I invite you to continue walking with me in this process through your prayers and your continued commitment to the life and mission of the Church in northeast Florida.

## First Step Commitment

As we begin this season of Lent, I ask you consider a call to prayer – to unite your heart to the Lord in deeper and more fruitful ways – and to enter into a time of pilgrimage – visiting the Misión de Dios/National Shrine to Our Lady of La Leche or another of our incredible historical places of Catholic heritage – so that we might awaken our connections of past, present, and future, united in faith and purpose, throughout the Diocese of St. Augustine.
