



FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The liturgical readings given for this Sunday directly speak to the Catechumens “ELECT” as they enter these final weeks of Spiritual Preparation to be welcomed into the “One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church” on the Easter Vigil Mass. Next three Sundays are referred to as the scrutinizes where the readings and the gospels are specifically centered on the “ELECT”. The purpose of the Scrutinies is “to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful “in the hearts of the Elect and to “strengthen all that is upright, strong and good”. OCIA 141. Let us pray for the Elect in their final spiritual preparation and for each of us to strengthen our spiritual journey. And so, Jesus’s meeting of the Samaritan woman at the well in today’s gospel, simply reveal the profound Catholic truths about grace, worship, and evangelization.

First, Jesus reveals Himself as the source of living water. When He says, “Whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst,” He is speaking of sanctifying grace — the divine life poured into our souls. This living water is given to us especially through Baptism and continually nourished through the Sacraments, particularly the Eucharist. Our hearts are restless without God; only Christ satisfies the deepest thirst of the human soul.

Second, Jesus addresses her broken past — not to condemn her, but to heal her. This reveals the heart of the Gospel. God knows our sins, yet He seeks us out. For Catholics and Catechumens, this is a powerful reminder of the gift of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Christ does not shame us; He restores us.

Third, Jesus teaches about true worship: “God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in Spirit and truth.” True worship is not merely external ritual, nor is it merely emotional. It is worship grounded in truth — fulfilled in the Church Christ established and expressed most perfectly in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

Finally, the woman becomes a missionary. After encountering Christ, she leaves her water jar behind — a symbol of her old life — and runs to tell others. An authentic encounter with Jesus always leads to evangelization. Faith is never meant to be private. It overflows and that’s exactly we see in the parable of the Samaritan woman. Let us have the courage then to discard old life. Let us grow in confidence to live a new life in Christ Jesus, who desires to deepen our love so that we may be eternally loving.

For Roman Catholics: return regularly to the well — the Sacraments, our spiritual sustenance.

For Catechumens: persevere — you are being led to the living water, Jesus Christ.

For all of us: let Christ quench your thirst, heal your past, and send you forth to evangelize. Have a Blessed Lenten Journey!

Rite of Election

The celebration of the Rite of Election (or Enrollment of Names) closes the period of the catechumenate. In this ancient rite of the Church, the Bishop listens to the testimony of the sponsors, godparents, and assembly. Based upon this testimony, he judges their state of readiness and "elects" or "chooses" them to receive the sacraments of initiation at the coming Easter Vigil.



Let us continue to pray for our OCIA catechumens and candidates as they enter the final stages of preparation towards the Sacraments of Initiation.


