

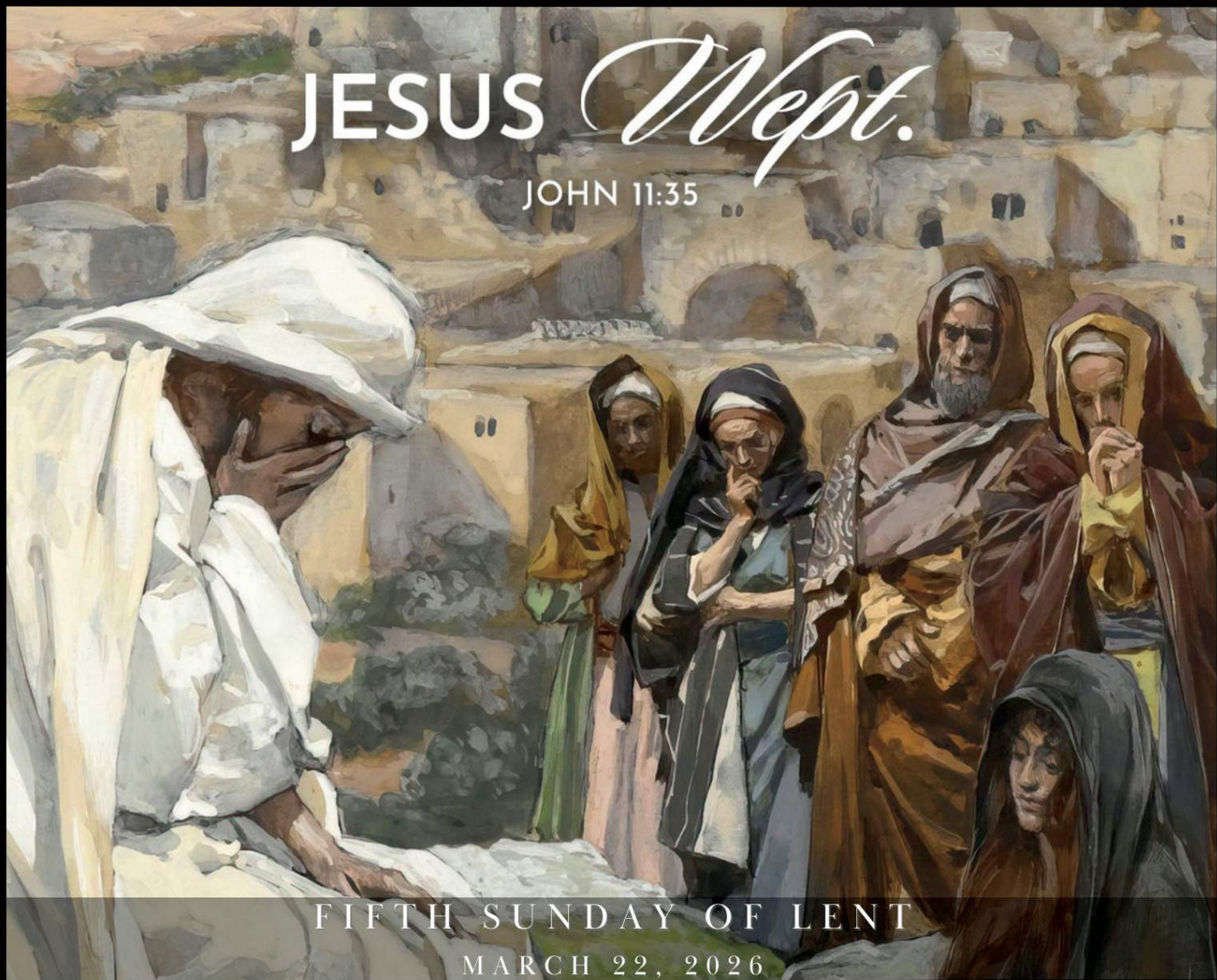

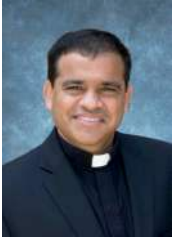

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"I AM THE RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE"



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The Fifth Sunday of Gospel proclaims the raising of Lazarus (John 11:1–45) for the Third Scrutiny, reveals Jesus as “the Resurrection and the Life.” This moment is especially meaningful for the Elect, who are preparing to pass from the darkness of sin into the new life of grace through Baptism. Lazarus, lying in the tomb for four days, is a powerful image of the human condition without Christ—bound by sin and unable to save ourselves.

Yet Jesus enters this reality with both divine authority and deep compassion. He weeps with those who mourn, showing that God is never distant from our suffering. Then He cries out, “Lazarus, come out!”—a command that brings life where there was death. This is the same saving power that will be given to the Elect in the Sacraments of Initiation. Through Baptism, they will be called out of the tomb of sin into new and eternal life in Christ.



The command, “Untie him and let him go,” reminds us that conversion is both personal and communal. The Church walks with the Elect, helping to free them from what binds them and supporting them in their new life of grace.



For the Elect: Trust in Jesus who calls you by name. Surrender anything that keeps you bound and open your heart fully to the new life He offers.

For the Faithful: Renew your own Baptismal promises. Turn away from sin and allow Christ to bring you again from death to life through the Sacraments. Support the Elect with prayer, encouragement, and witness, so that all may walk in the freedom and joy of the Risen Lord.

SAINT MARTHA

It is to Martha that Jesus reveals the profound mysteries of His mission: "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in me, though he dies, yet shall he live." (John 11:25) The paschal mystery is summed up in these words addressed to a woman.

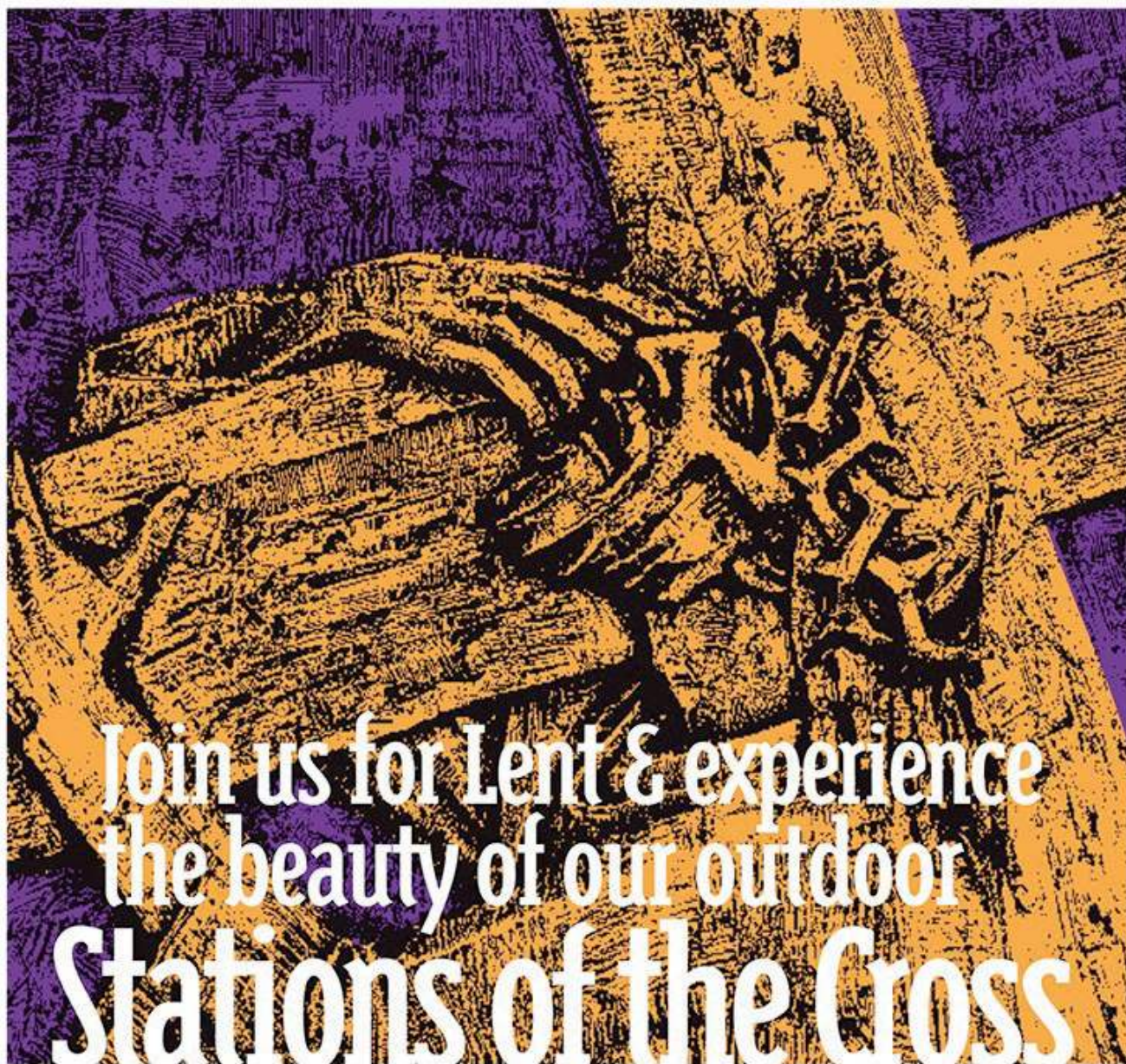
