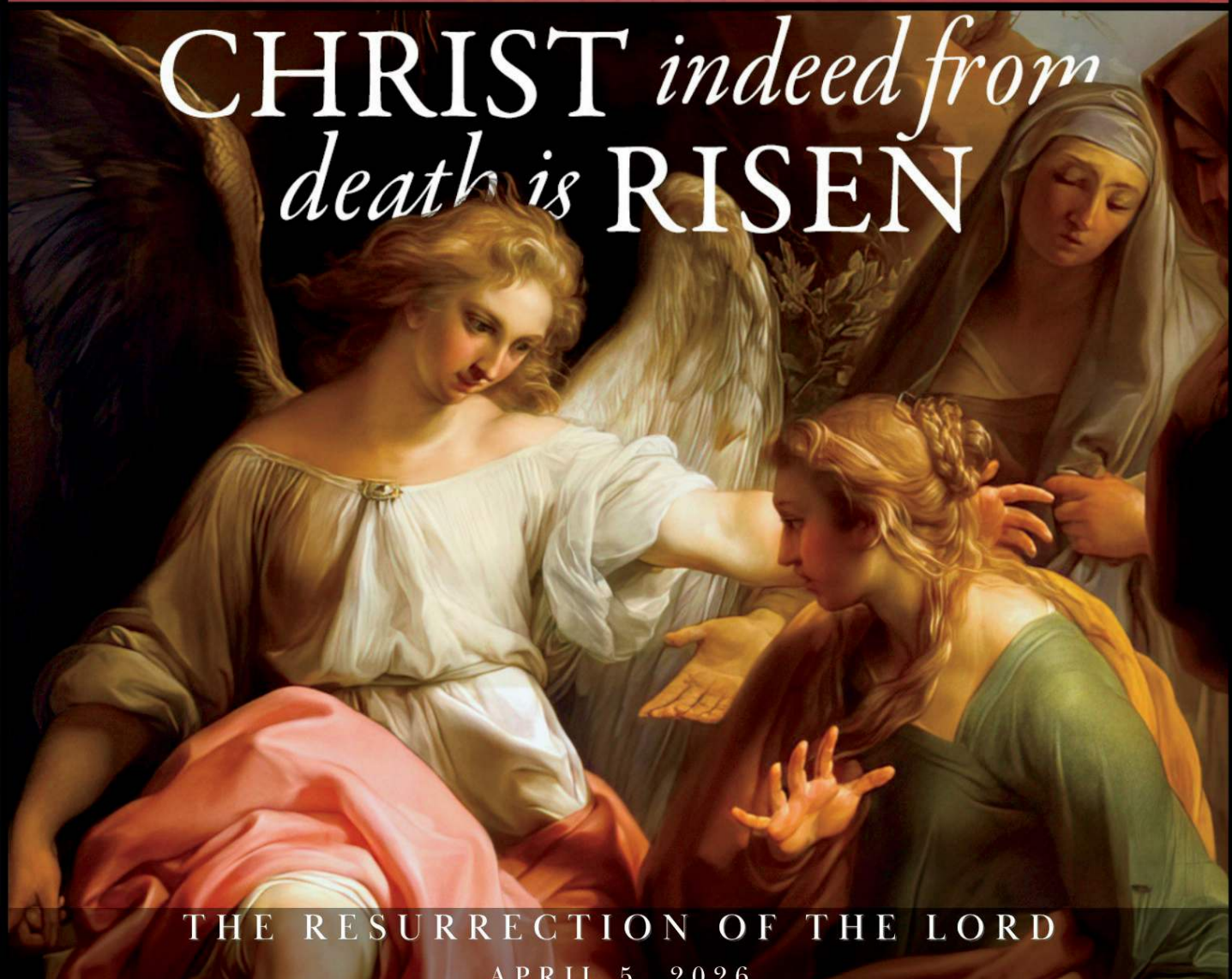

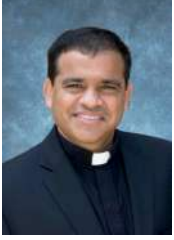

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



ALLELUIA! CHRIST IS RISEN!

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

The journey we began in ashes on Ash Wednesday brings us to the fire of Easter. Unlike the fire of death and destruction, we encounter a purifying, life-transforming fire that gives light to a dark and despairing world. It is the fire that lights paschal Candle which proclaims: “the light of Christ”. It is the fire that brings us into the light of Christ and lights up our own path. It is up to us now to carry our candle into the darkness and light up the world.

On this glorious day of Easter, we celebrate the heart of our Catholic faith: the victory of Jesus Christ over sin and death, light over darkness, hope against despair. The Resurrection is not simply an event of the past—it is a living reality that transforms our lives today. As St. Paul proclaims, “If Christ has not been raised, our faith is in vain.” But Christ has been raised, and because He lives, we have hope.

Easter reminds us that no darkness is greater than God's light. The tomb is empty. Sin is conquered. Death is defeated. This is the truth that gives meaning to our lives, especially in moments of suffering, doubt, and struggle. Just as Christ passed from death to life, we too are called to rise with Him—leaving behind sin and embracing new life in grace.

Through our Baptism, we share in this Resurrection. We are not meant to remain in the “tombs” of fear, resentment, or despair. Instead, we are invited to live as Easter people of joy, hope, and renewal. The Risen Lord meets us where we are, just as He met Mary Magdalene, the apostles, and the disciples on the road. He calls each of us by name and says, “Do not be afraid.”

Easter is also a call to mission. The apostles did not keep the good news to themselves—they went forth with courage to proclaim Christ to the world. In the same way, we are sent out to witness to our faith in our families, workplaces, and communities. Our lives should reflect the joy of the Resurrection: in our kindness, our forgiveness, our love for one another.

Dear Friends, we are Easter people, people of the Resurrection and people of Hope. We must strive to be men and women of hope, speak the language of hope, avoid negative conversation, be optimistic and positive, never give up, try repeatedly, take a different approach, and be a remarkable sign of hope for the world.

Let us then rejoice today, not only with our words but with our lives. Let us renew our faith, deepen our trust in God, and commit ourselves to living as true disciples of the Risen Christ. May the peace of the Risen Lord fill your hearts and your homes with joy and your lives with hope. And may you always walk in the light of His victory. Alleluia!
