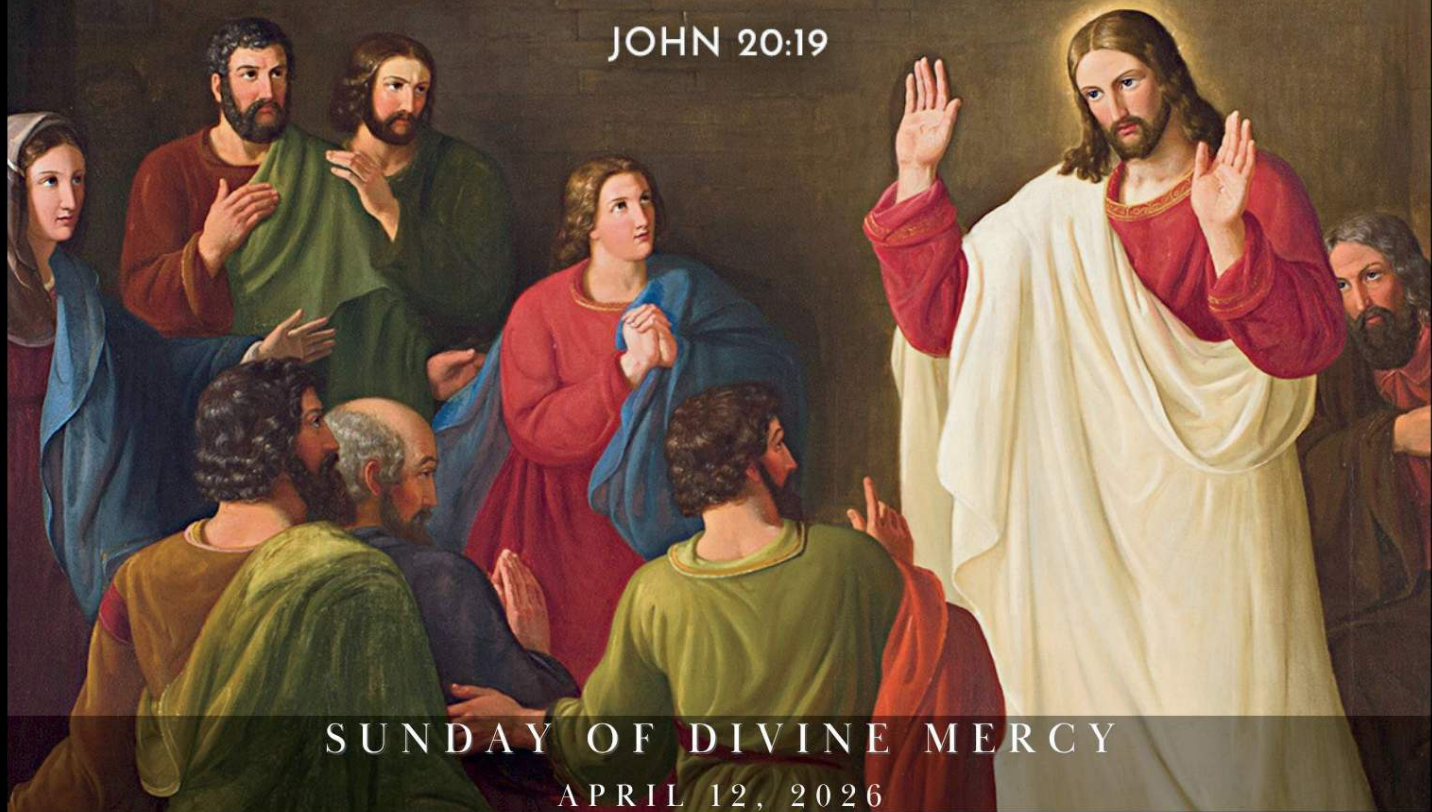

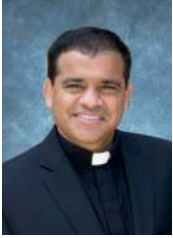


USHERS— PEOPLE NEEDED

The Great Promise of Divine Mercy Sunday

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Divine Mercy Sunday may be the greatest day of the year because of the immeasurable amount of grace Jesus promised to pour forth on this day. In the private revelation accepted publicly by the Church, Jesus made a specific promise to Saint Faustina about Divine Mercy Sunday:

“On that day . . . The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.” (Diary, 699)

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, the Church invites us to stand before one of the most consoling truths of our faith: God's mercy is not limited, not earned, and never exhausted—it is freely given to those who trust in Him.

This great promise is rooted in the very heart of the Gospel. When the risen Christ appears to His disciples, He does not come with condemnation, but with peace: “Peace be with you.” He breathes the Holy Spirit upon them and gives them the authority to forgive sins. This moment reveals that Divine Mercy is not an abstract idea, it is a living reality entrusted to the Church, especially through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

The message of Divine Mercy was powerfully renewed in the Church through Saint Faustina Kowalska, who received visions of Jesus emphasizing trust in His mercy.

AROUND OUR PARISH

Through her, Christ gave the Church a profound promise: that on this feast, the soul that goes to Confession and receives Holy Communion with trust will receive complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. This is not a new doctrine, but a deeper unfolding of the infinite merits of Christ's Passion.

St. Pope John Paul II, who canonized Saint Faustina and established this feast for the universal Church, called Divine Mercy "the answer to the world's deepest wounds." And indeed, we live in a world marked by fear, guilt, and brokenness. Yet today, Christ reminds us that no sin is greater than His mercy—if only we open our hearts.

But this promise comes with a response: Trust. Jesus repeatedly said, "Jesus, I trust in You." Trust means surrendering our pride, letting go of despair, and believing that God's love is greater than our failures. It also calls us to become merciful ourselves: "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy." We who receive mercy must extend it—to forgiveness, to show compassion, to heal wounds in others.

So today, let us not stand at a distance. Let us approach the Heart of Christ with confidence. In the Sacraments, especially Confession and the Eucharist, the floodgates of mercy are opened. The Risen Lord still shows His wounds, not to accuse us, but to heal us. On this Divine Mercy Sunday, the great promise is clear: no matter how far we have wandered, the mercy of God is always greater. Let us trust, receive, and become living witnesses to that mercy in the world.

Hearty welcome to our New Catholics!

On behalf of our Parish Community, I heartily welcome our newly initiated Catholics who have entered the Church at this blessed Easter Vigil. Through the waters of Baptism, the seal of Confirmation, and the gift of the Holy Eucharist, you now share fully in the life of Christ and His Church. Your journey of faith, prayer, and conversion has brought you to this sacred moment, and we rejoice with you as members of our parish family.



May I take this moment to thank Deacon Ray Stiles, our OCIA Coordinator together with Deacon Pat and the entire team of committed parishioners for their work of teaching the Faith of the Church and preparing them to embrace the Roman Catholic Church. It would not be possible without their gift of time and talent and a word of thanks and appreciation to all ministries of our parish who have helped to celebrate the Resurrection of Lord in a beautiful and profound way. Your love, service and commitment are very much appreciated.

May the light of the Risen Lord guide you always, strengthen you in faith, and fill your hearts with His peace and mercy. Welcome Home. Christ is Risen, Alleluia.

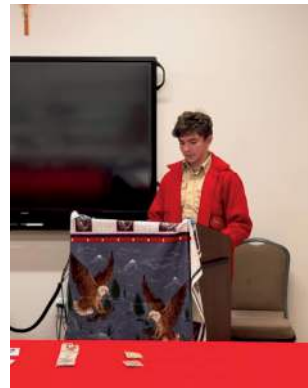
