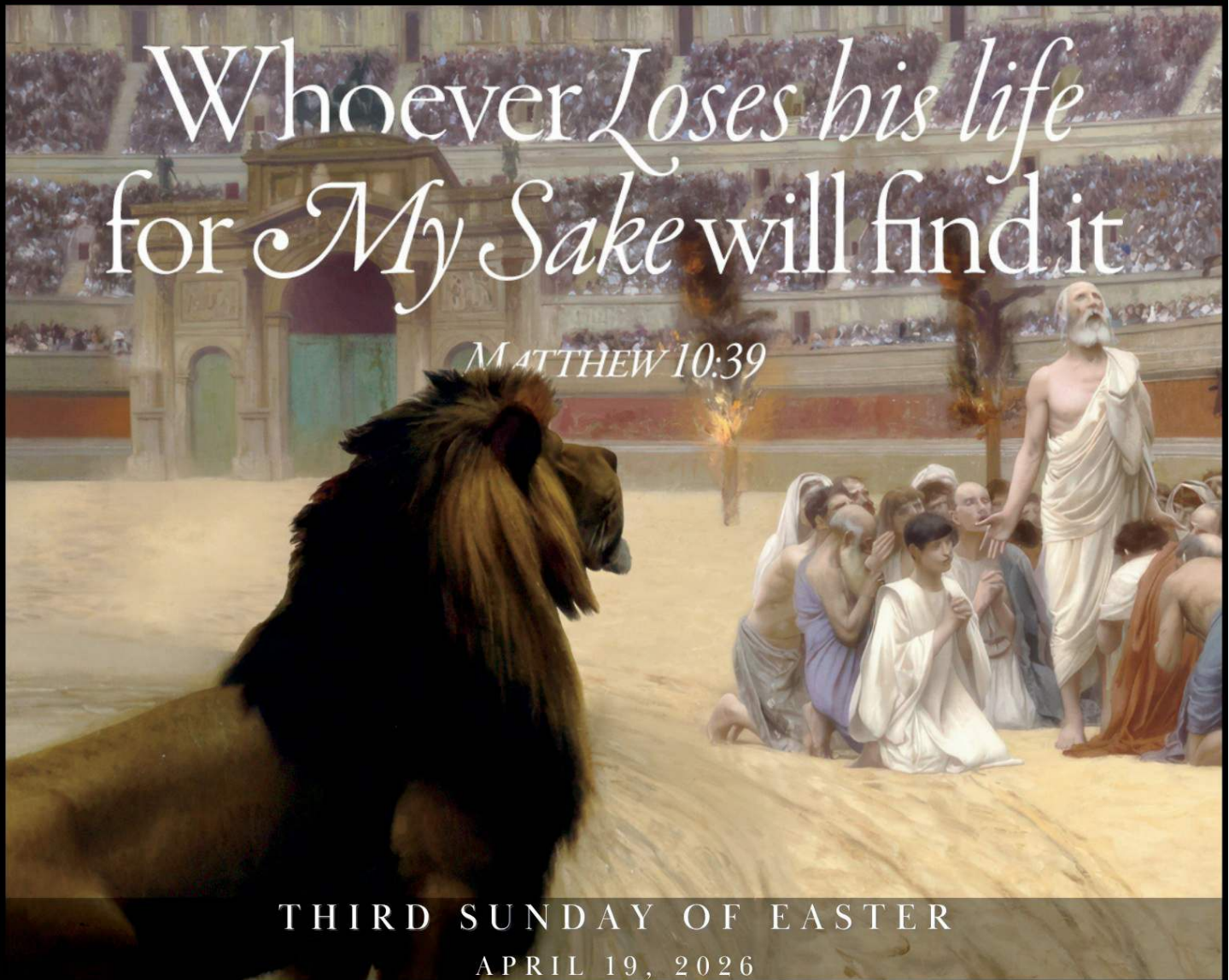

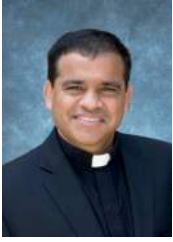

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

On behalf of our Parish Community, I would like to sincerely thank our Bishop Erik T. Pohlmeier, Diocese of St. Augustine for celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation and blessing our future leaders of our Catholic Church. My sincere thanks and appreciation also to Mrs. Colleen Gomez, DRE, teachers and her entire team for instructing and preparing these students for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Let us keep them in our prayers so that the Spirit of God may continue to guide, lead and use the gifts of the Holy Spirit for the greater glory of God and for one another. Remember Students, you have received not just a Sacrament, but a Mission. In Confirmation, the Holy Spirit has sealed you with His gifts—wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord—not as treasures to keep hidden, but as light to shine in the Church and in the world.

Look at the life of St. Paul the Apostle. Once fearful and uncertain, he became bold through the Holy Spirit, preaching Christ to the nations. The same Spirit now lives in you. This means your faith is not meant to remain private, it must become active.

In the Church, use your gifts to build up others. Wisdom helps you see life as God sees it; understanding deepens your love for the faith; piety draws you closer to prayer and the sacraments. Be present—at Mass, in service, in community. Encourage those who are weak and be witnesses of joy.

In the world, your gifts become even more urgent. Counsel helps you guide friends toward truth; fortitude gives you courage to stand for what is right, even when it's difficult. Knowledge helps you recognize God's presence in everyday life, and fear of the Lord keeps you rooted in reverence and humility.

Remember the words fulfilled at Pentecost—the Spirit transforms ordinary people into courageous disciples. That same fire is within you. So go forward with confidence. Let your words speak truth, your actions show love, and your lives reflect Christ. The world needs what you have received. Don't be afraid to use it. Because the Risen Lord walks with us in our journey just like in Today's Gospel as He walks with them on the way to Emmaus.

In reflecting on this, St. Francis de Sales notes, Jesus, appearing as a pilgrim, encounters two of His disciples on the road to Emmaus. He questions them about their conversation on His resurrection, but they do not recognize Him. After they confess the doubt, they are experiencing concerning His Resurrection, Jesus can instruct and enlighten them with His words. Then as Jesus breaks bread with them, they recognize their risen Savior and believe in Him.



# AROUND OUR PARISH

It is a very good sign when a person listens willingly to the divine word. We are in continual communication with God, who never ceases to speak to our hearts through inspirations and sacred movements. God gives to each of us the inspirations needed to live, work, and preserve our life and faith in the spirit.

Faith is the best friend of our human spirit. Faith assures us of God's infinite goodness and thus gives us sufficient reason to love God with all our power. We must nurture well what we hear inwardly and outwardly of the divine word so that it strengthens us. Be devoted then to the word of God whether you hear it in familiar conversation with spiritual friends or in sermons. Be like the disciples. With joy, let the words of Our Savior nourish your heart as a precious hope-filled healing ointment and may you carry out the work of God which you been commissioned through the Sacrament of Confirmation.



On a different note, that as you all know I will be completing 25 years as Priest in God's Vineyard on April 29th. So, I invite you to Join me in thanking the Lord for the gift of the Priesthood, to celebrate and to pray for more Vocations in the Priesthood and religious Life after all the Masses on the weekend of April 25th & 26th, 2026.
