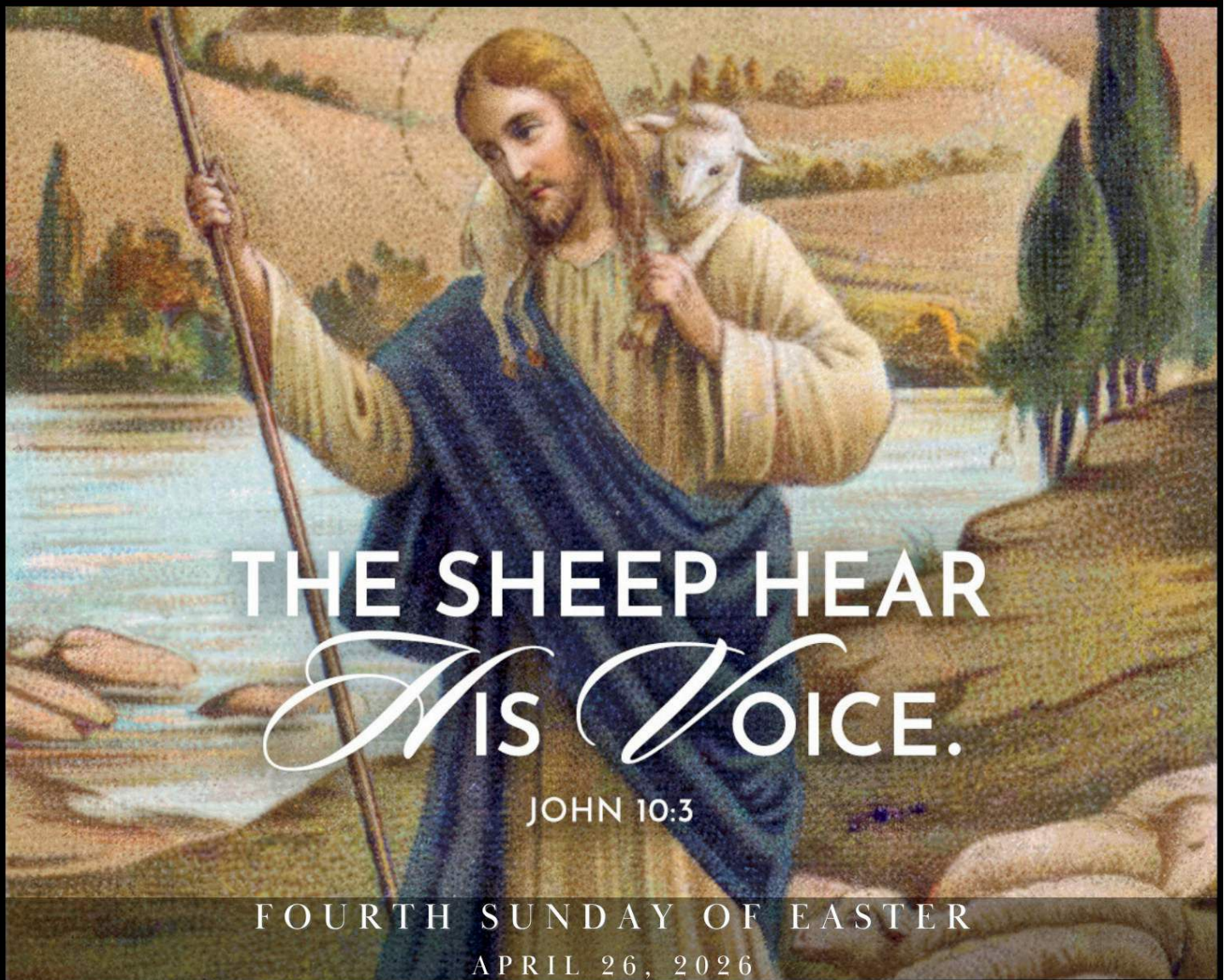

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

“JESUS, THE GOOD SHEPHERD, THE ETERNAL HIGH PRIEST”



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The Catholic Church proclaims that the priesthood of Jesus Christ is eternal, unique, and unrepeatable. As taught in Sacred Scripture, especially in the Letter to the Hebrews, Christ is the High Priest who offered Himself once for all as the perfect sacrifice for the salvation of the world. Everything that the priesthood of the Old Covenant prefigured finds its fulfillment in Christ Jesus., “one mediator between God and men” (CCC 1544). Unlike the priests of the Old Covenant, His priesthood is eternal; it is rooted in His divine person and continues forever in heaven, where He constantly intercedes for us before the Father.

Christ is also revealed as the [Good Shepherd](#), who knows His sheep, calls them by name, and lays down His life for them. His shepherding is not merely symbolic—it is active and ongoing. He guides, nourishes, and protects His Church through grace and truth. This pastoral mission did not end with His Ascension but continues through the Sacramental life of the Church.

In His wisdom, Christ chose to share His priesthood in a sacramental way through the ministerial priesthood. This is what the Church means by saying that the priest, by virtue of the Sacrament of Holy Orders, ordained priests act in persona Christi capitis—in the person of Christ the Head. Because Christ is the source of all priesthood: the priest of the old law was a figure of Christ, and the priest of the new law acts in the person of Christ (CCC 1548). This means that when a priest celebrates the Eucharist, forgives sins, or proclaims the Gospel, it is truly



Christ Himself who acts through him.



In the modern world—marked by secularism, moral confusion, and spiritual hunger—the ministerial priesthood is more essential than ever. Priests stand as visible signs of Christ's presence among His people. They bring the sacraments, especially the Holy Eucharist, which is the source and summit of Christian life. They shepherd souls, teach truth in charity, and offer spiritual guidance in a world that often loses sight of God.

The priest is not merely a functionary or leader, but a sacramental bridge between God and humanity. His life is configured to Christ the Good Shepherd, called to lay down his life in service, humility, and love. In a fragmented and restless world, the faithful depend on the priest to encounter Christ in a real and transformative way.

Therefore, the one eternal priesthood of Christ and the ministerial priesthood of the Church are inseparably linked. Christ remains the one High Priest, while ordained priests serve as His instruments, making His saving work present in every age. Through them, the voice of the Good Shepherd continues to call, heal, and lead His people to eternal life. Let us be thankful for the gift of priesthood, because Christ the Good Shepherd, the Eternal High Priest wants to lead everyone towards His Eternal Homeland.

With a grateful and humble heart, I thank each one of you for being here today to celebrate this Jubilee Mass with me, especially, Rev. Fr. Anthony Bonela, MSFS, the Provincial Superior of the USA Province, my Fransalian and the Diocesan Priests, friends and the Holy Spirit Parish & School Community. Your presence is a great gift, but even more, your prayers—offered for me and with me more than words can express.

Over these 25 years, I have experienced the Lord's faithfulness through the support, love, and encouragement of my family, friends and every one of you. Today is not just a personal milestone, but a celebration of God's grace working in all of us as a community of faith.
