FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

MARIAN MONTH OF MAY



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

In the Catholic tradition, the month of May is lovingly dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God and our spiritual Mother. This devotion developed over centuries as the Church recognized Mary's unique role in salvation history—her “yes” to God brought forth Jesus Christ, our Redeemer. May, a season of new life and beauty, fittingly reflects the spiritual fruitfulness and purity of Mary.



Honoring Mary in this month is not merely sentimental; it is deeply doctrinal. The Church teaches that Mary is the perfect disciple, the model of faith, humility, and obedience. By turning to her, we are always led more deeply to her Son. As she herself said at Cana, “Do whatever He tells you.” True Marian devotion is always Christ-centered.



One of the most powerful ways we honor Mary is through the Holy Rosary. This prayer is not just repetition,

but meditation on the mysteries of Christ's life—His Incarnation, Passion, Resurrection, and Glory—seen through the eyes of Mary. In praying the Rosary, we reflect the Gospel passage, allowing it to shape our hearts and transform our lives. It becomes a school of prayer, contemplation, and conversion, especially in a world often distracted and restless.

- 5 **Announce the first mystery and recite the Our Father.**
- 6 **Recite ten Hail Marys.**
- 7 **Recite the Glory Be and the Fatima Prayer.**
- 8 **Announce the second mystery. Recite the Our Father and repeat the steps through the rosary.**
- 9 **After completing the mysteries, recite the Hail Holy Queen & end with the Sign of the Cross.**

The beautiful tradition of May Crowning also expresses our love and reverence for Mary. By placing a crown upon her image, we acknowledge her as Queen of Heaven and Earth as one who reigns with His Son, Jesus, interceding for us as a loving mother. It is a visible act of devotion that reminds us to honor her virtues and entrust our lives to her maternal care.

In this month of May, we are invited to renew our devotion: to pray the Rosary daily, to imitate Mary's faith, and to draw closer to Christ through her. For where Mary is, there Christ is always near

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

May 9th is a profound day and moment in the life of our young children: First Holy Communion. On this day, they receive for the first time Jesus Christ Himself—both Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—truly present in the Holy Eucharist. This is the fulfillment of His promise: "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him."

Through this sacrament, the child is more deeply united with Christ and His Church. Sanctifying grace is strengthened, their souls are nourished with divine life, and they are given spiritual strength to grow in holiness. The Eucharist becomes their spiritual food for the journey, shaping their hearts in love, humility, and charity.

First Holy Communion is not just a single day of joy—it is the beginning of a lifelong relationship with Christ. From this day forward, these children are invited again to the altar, where heaven meets earth, and where they are transformed more fully into the likeness of Christ. It's a Sacred Duty of the parents to bring their children regularly to the Church to receive Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. Please, do not neglect or take away from the children the privilege of receiving Jesus in the Holy Mass and teaching the Catholic Faith to them.

May this gift remain alive in them always, drawing them closer to God and guiding them in faith, hope, and love. May our Blessed Mother continue to intercede for us from above.

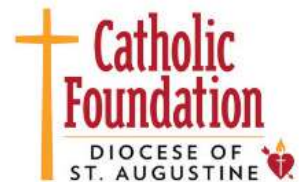
