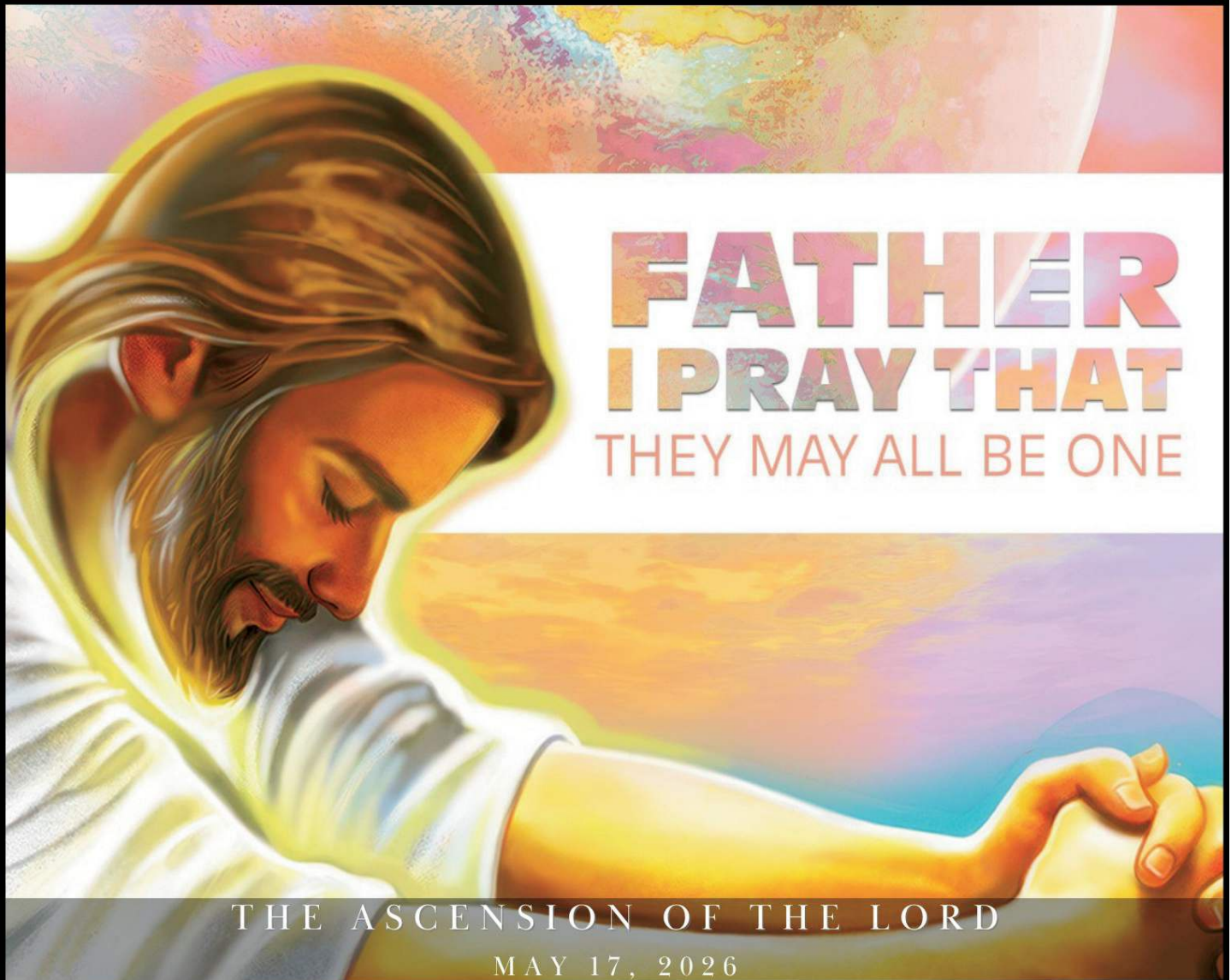

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Today, the Church joyfully celebrates the great feast of the Ascension of the Lord. Forty days after His Resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven before His disciples. The Ascension is not the “departure” of Jesus from us, but the fulfillment of His saving mission. Christ returns to the Father in glory, opening the gates of heaven for all humanity.

The Ascension teaches us three important Catholic truths:

First, Jesus is truly Lord and King. He is seated at the right hand of the Father, reigning in glory and interceding for us. Our faith is centered on the living Christ who reigns forever. Even in the struggles, confusion, and suffering of the modern world, Christ remains victorious.

Second, Ascension reveals our destiny. Where Christ the Head has gone, we, the members of His Body, are called to follow. Heaven is our true home. The world often tempts us to live only for material success, pleasure, or earthly recognition. But the Ascension reminds us to keep our hearts fixed on eternal life. As Saint Paul says, “Seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God.”

Third, before ascending, Jesus gave the Church a Mission: “Go and make disciples of all Nations.” Every baptized Catholic is called to witness to Christ — in our families, schools, workplaces, and society. We evangelize not only by words, but by holy lives, charity, forgiveness, purity, and fidelity to the Gospel.

The Ascension is also a message of hope. Jesus promised, “I am with you always.” Though He Ascended bodily into heaven, He remains truly present in the Holy Eucharist, in His Church, and through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Therefore, let us not live with fear or discouragement. Our lives are the only Bible some people will ever read! We need Christian to make Christians. Full of life and energy or tired and weary, let us choose to give faithful witness to who we are and whose we are.... Be disciples of Jesus wherever we may be and whatever we may be doing. Let us live with our eyes lifted toward heaven, our feet grounded in faithful service, and our hearts united with Christ. May the Ascended Lord strengthen us to live as joyful witnesses until the day we share fully in His heavenly glory. Have a blessed week!

A Catholic parish is a witness and part of the living Body of Christ. This is where we continue the mission of Jesus Christ through our liturgies, ministries and services. This is where we publicly express our faith, joining together with others to give witness of our communion with God and in fellowship with one another.

There are many reasons to register:

- A sense of belonging and identity in a parish community
- Being included in the active status of the parish helps in the planning for the liturgical and logistical needs of the parish
- Gives the parish a way to contact and connect with you
- Be able to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, or Holy Matrimony
- Have the ability to complete the diocesan eligibility form and/or letter of good standing to be a sponsor/godparent in Baptism or Confirmation
- Allows you to receive important parish information or alerts in times of emergency such as hurricane closure/opening updates

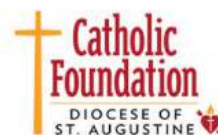

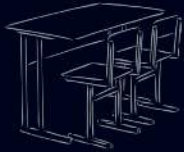
