HAPPY FEAST OF PENTECOST



My Dear Friends,

We celebrate our Paternal Feast, the Feast of Pentecost (the "birth-day" of the Church), the coming of the Holy Spirit upon those gathered faithfully, who are open and joyful to receive the Holy Spirit. In the words of Saint Francis de Sales, "The Holy Spirit is like a fountain of living water that flows into our hearts to spread divine love in us. Divine love is something infinitely more than all other forms of love. The love that the Spirit gives empowers us to serve God. Our works that flow from the Spirit's love are vigorous and virtuous and grow like mustard seeds. It is a wonderful thing that this Divine Spirit does not hesitate to dwell in us".
