

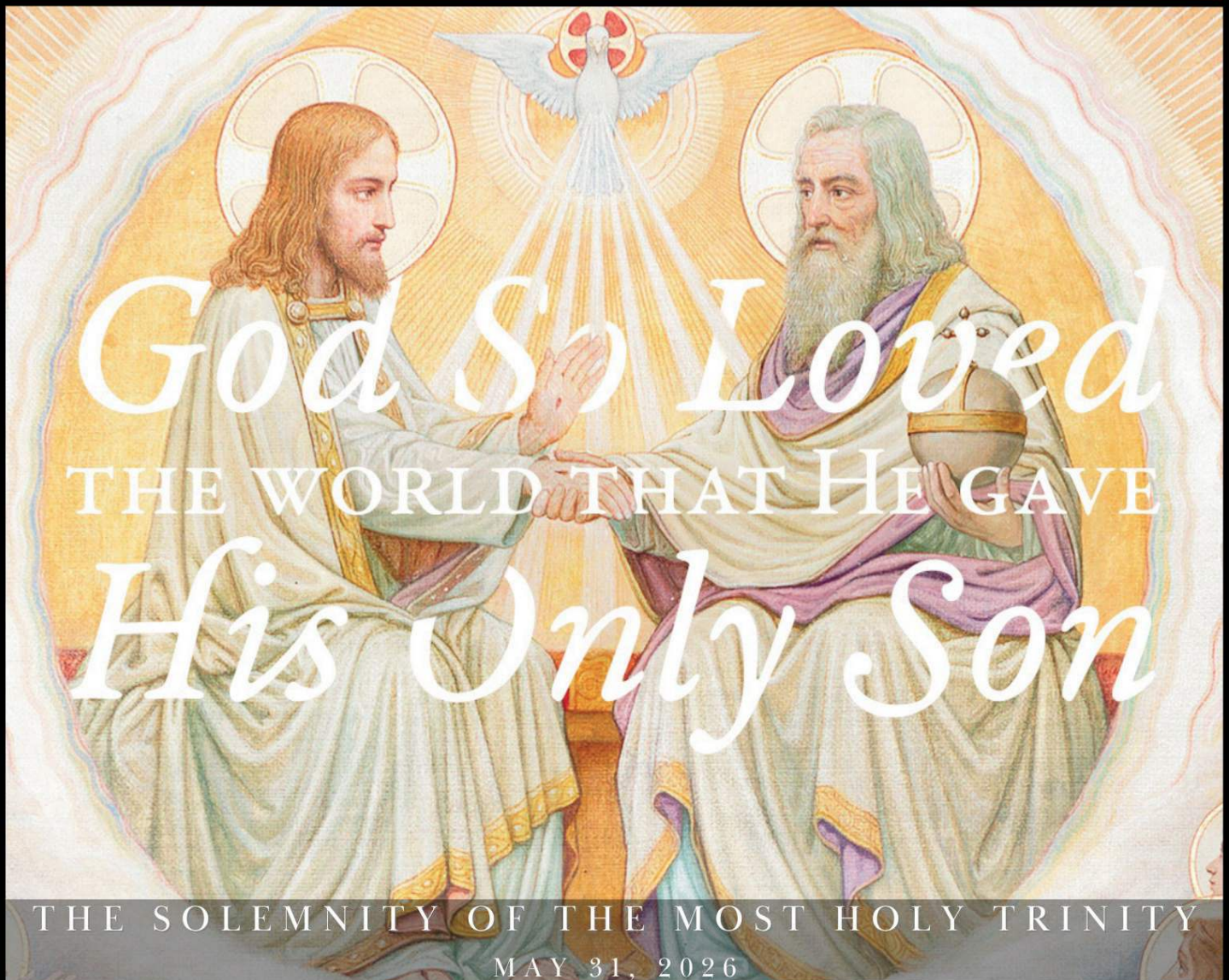

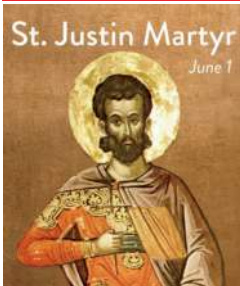

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY



My Sisters and Brothers,

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity invites us to contemplate the deepest mystery of our Catholic faith: One God in Three Divine Persons — the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, in a perfect communion of love. Trinity is not a mathematical problem to solve, but a divine mystery to adore, believe, and live.

In the Gospel, Jesus reveals the Father and promises the Holy Spirit. From all eternity, the Father loves the Son, the Son loves the Father, and the Holy Spirit is the bond of that eternal divine love. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that the mystery of the Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. Every time we make the Sign of the Cross, we proclaim our faith in the Triune God.

The Father is our Creator who lovingly made us in His image. The Son is our Savior who became man, died on the Cross, and rose again for our salvation. The Holy Spirit is our Sanctifier who dwells within us, guiding, strengthening, and transforming us into holy people.

The Holy Trinity also teaches us how to live. Trinity is a communion of unity, love, self-giving, and perfect relationship. In a world filled with division, selfishness, anger, and isolation, Catholic Christians are called to reflect the life of the Trinity in our families, schools, workplaces, and parish communities. We are called to love one another, forgive one another, serve one another, and remain united in truth and charity.

Parents reflect the Trinity when they create a home filled with faith and sacrificial love. Children reflect the Trinity when they obey, respect, and care for others. Priests and religious reflect the Trinity by dedicating their lives to God and His people. Every baptized Catholic Christian is called to become a living witness of Trinitarian love.



Today, let us thank the Father for creating us, the Son for redeeming us, and the Holy Spirit for sanctifying us. May every Sign of the Cross remind us that we belong to the Most Holy Trinity and are called to live in the love, unity, and holiness of God every day.

CONGRATULATIONS TO MATTHEW DAVID AND HIS DISCERNMENT WITH THE CAPUCHIN FRANCISCANS

On June 1, Matthew David will begin his discernment with the Capuchin Franciscan Friars of the Province of the Sacred Stigmata of Saint Francis. Matthew has been a parishioner of Holy Spirit since 1985, when his father, Ignacio David, was stationed at Mayport Naval Station. Recently, Matthew retired as a Chief Warrant Officer 3 Bandmaster after more than 20 years of faithful service to our country. At Holy Spirit, he has been active in both the music and lector ministries.



Matthew will now begin a five-year formation process with the Capuchin Franciscans. The first stage is postulancy, a one-year period during which he and the other postulants will learn about Capuchin life through daily prayer, fraternity, and ministry. This stage of formation will take place in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The second stage is the novitiate, which is located at San Lorenzo Friary in Santa Ynez, California. During this year, postulants receive the novice habit and the title of "Brother." Although they do not yet take religious vows, they are expected to live the vowed life. The novitiate includes continued classes on religious subjects and Capuchin spirituality, along with significant time devoted to prayer and meditation. The third stage is post-novitiate, a three-year period that begins with temporary profession and concludes with perpetual profession. During this time, Matthew will return to the province and participate in communal prayer life, internal classes, and active fraternal and external ministries. After these five years of formation, the Provincial Council will determine whether Matthew will continue his studies in seminary, which would require approximately six additional years of preparation. Please keep Matthew in your prayers as he begins this journey of discernment and service to God and His Church.

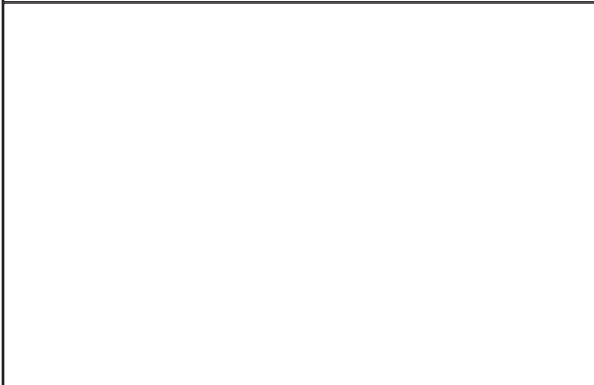
